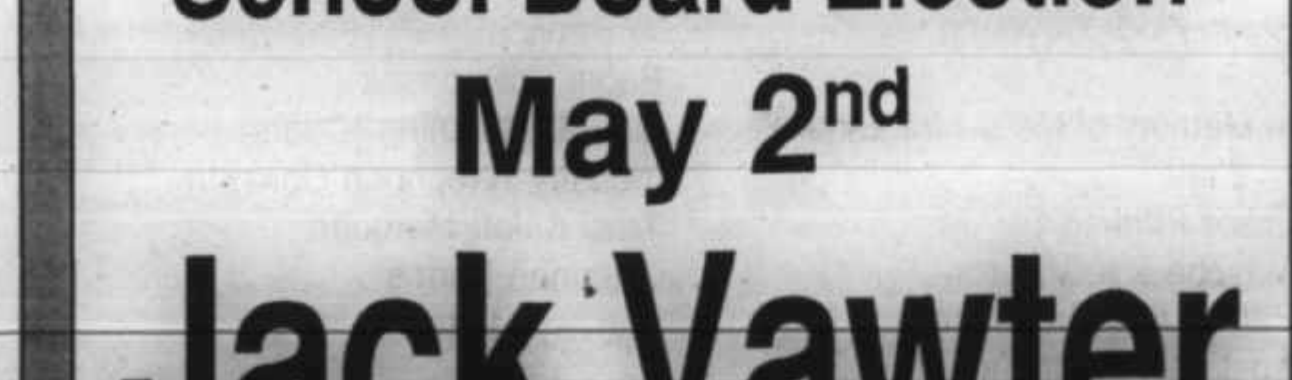
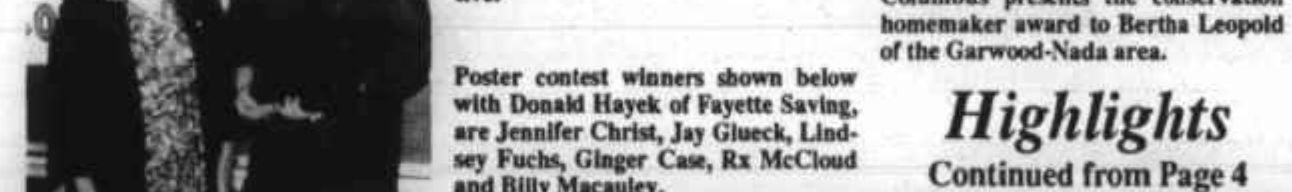
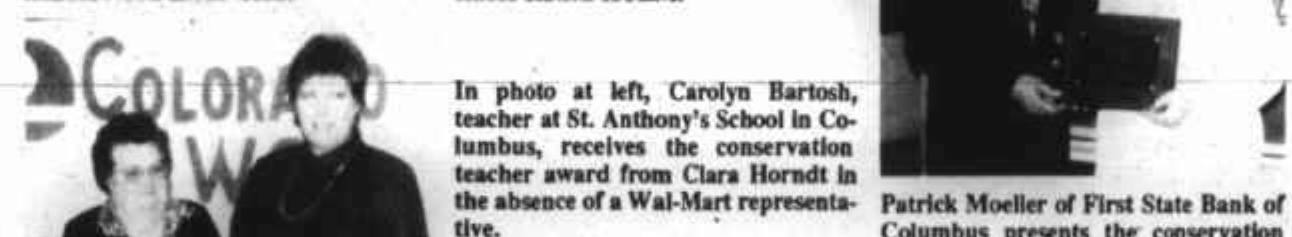
Conservation awards
