Information you can use from the IRS

FREE TAX HELP

For those needing tax questions answered or help with tax returns, the IRS is offering various FREE services including Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA), Tax Counseling for the Elderly (TCE), publications on specific tax subjects and Tele-Tax.

VITA is a group of IRS trained volunteers who prepare 1040EZs, 1040As, and simple 1040s for low-income, elderly and/or non-English speaking taxpayers. Volunteers at some VITA locations also prepare prior year tax returns for those taxpayers who haven't filed in one or more years and need to catch up. VITA help is offered from Feb. 15 to March 15.

TCE, a program conducted by IRS certified volunteers, is to provide assistance and tax preparation for the elderly. These volunteers have special training to handle issues usually pertaining to tax returns of the elderly, such as pensions, credit for the elderly, social security, etc.

Tele-Tax is a service offering recorded tax information and assistance on specific issues. Call toll-free in South Texas, 1-800-829-4477.

IRS is NOT TOO LATE TO FILE

The IRS says it's not too late to voluntarily file delinquent personal income tax returns. Since Oct. 1, IRS has been looking for people who have not filed one or more years of returns. But, if they haven't begun to investigate you, then you should contact them and get those returns filed. "The advantage in doing that is, if you voluntarily file a correct, complete return first, no criminal penalties will apply," said IRS spokesperson Ann Ruiz.

The IRS says this is not an amnesty program. If tax is owed, the normal charges for interest, late filing penalty and late payment will still apply. If a taxpayer can show a good reason why he or she was unable to file a return, IRS may choose not to apply the penalties. This consideration would be determined on a case-by-case basis.

IRS will assist taxpayers in obtaining wage or nonemployee information, secure tax return forms for the years they need, and even help prepare the tax returns. They will also arrange installment agreements.

Ruiz also says, "Many taxpayers may actually be due refunds and they will forfeit it if they don't file a return within three years of the due date."

EARNED INCOME CREDIT

It's time to file tax returns for 1992 and over 14 million working families with children will be eligible for the Earned Income Credit (EIC), the Internal Revenue Service says.

"EIC is a refundable tax credit for working families who have earned income and adjusted gross income of less than \$22,370 in 1992," said Ann Ruiz, IRS spokesperson. "Keep in

mind that 'family' can mean either a one-parent or two-parent household. The best news is that families who qualify may be able to claim up to \$2,211, increased from \$2,020."

To claim the credit, a taxpayer must file a tax return and attach a Schedule EIC to Form 1040 or 1040A.

MORE THAN GROWING PAINS

Heel pain can be a symptom of any number of problems. When it occurs in early adolescents, especially just after they've begun a new sports or exercise program, there is a good chance the cause may be calcaneal apophysitis, or "Sever's disease". While heel pain in youngsters is often attributed to growing pains or dismissed entirely, parents should take seriously any report of foot discomfort. Sever's disease is an injury to the heel growth plate. Symptoms, which may worsen during a sports activity and subside afterward, include irritation in the heel and limping. Treatment may include limiting the child's sports activities and the wearing of an individually fitted shoe insert.

Children's bodies grow and change so rapidly that continuous and preventive care is often required to keep them on a healthy track.
