Requires approval in statewide election... Proposed amendment guards against income tax with vote

A proposed constitutional amendment endorsed by Lt. Gov. Bob Bullock would prevent the Texas Legislature from getting a wild hair and passing a state income tax, without giving voters the final say-so. Under the proposal, a simple-majority approval in a statewide election vote would be required before any income tax could take effect.
