TCI to add local channels to cable

The cable provider for Eagle Lake will be carrying local broadcast channels effective June 29.

TCI Cablevision of Central Texas announced May 27 that it must change its channel lineup to make room for local broadcast stations the system is now required by law to carry. Station KXLM-TV 45 will be added to the cable lineup the end of this month.

TCI, which serves Columbus and Eagle Lake, takes this action to comply with the "must carry" provision of

the 1992 Cable Act adopted by Congress in Oct. 1992. Under the regulation, cable operators are required to carry all local television broadcast stations.

"We regret any inconvenience this may cause our customers and are doing our best to avoid disruption," said General Manager Bill Berekky Jr.

The 1992 Cable Act will mean other changes for Eagle Lake viewers down the line. As the local stations are added, TCI may need to reposition
