North Lake Missionary Baptist Church missionary lessons for May

Theme: Peacemakers, Not Troublemakers.

Jesus taught his disciples at the foot of Mt. Olive, Matthew 5:9, saying, "Blessed are the peacemakers for they shall be called the children of God."

First week: With Self. Genesis 4:1-7. Satan is the author of trouble. He will lead us in but will not lead us out.

He will change our course. Only a born of the spirit person shows forth peace because the Holy Spirit is the believer's indwelling paraklet (helper).

Cain had self confidence that his offering would please God. But he lost self control when he failed. His self expression caused him to be self centered, not self conscious, of the fact that God had a purpose, plan and providence would provide.

Abel's self determination to please God made him self indulgent, meaning submitting himself under the commandments of the Almighty God. The birth anchors the soul, that part of us that never dies. 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Diabetics: Use Certain Medicines Cautiously

Maintaining proper control of blood sugar levels is a primary concern for diabetic patients. Without such control, a number of undesirable complications can result. Certain prescription and non-prescription medicines have been reported to lower the blood sugar which is called "hypoglycemia" or increase blood sugar, which is called "hyperglycemia."

Low Blood Sugar: According to a recent report in *Postgraduate Medicine*, the ingestion of excessive amounts of alcohol is considered the major cause of hypoglycemia related coma and death in all age groups of diabetics in the United States. An article in *Diabetes Care* indicates that high doses of aspirin, such as doses used in relief of arthritis symptoms, can cause low blood sugar levels in both diabetics and nondiabetics.

High Blood Sugar: Diuretics or "water pills" may increase blood sugar levels in diabetics after 2 to 4 weeks of therapy. Other medicines that may increase blood sugar include the combined oral contraceptives (type that contains estrogen and progestin), cortisone-type medicines, and certain decongestant medicines such as phenylephrine, pseudoephedrine, and phenylpropanolamine. Medical experts feel that, while none of these medicines should be avoided entirely by diabetics, such medicines should be used with considerable caution.
