September opener looks good for hunters

Hunters anxious to begin the fall season should have had a good opening Sept. 1.

Mourning dove and white-winged dove numbers are up and South Texas has a new opening date. Texans also get to participate in an early Teal season for the second year.

May call-count surveys by Texas Parks and Wildlife personnel, indicated a statewide white-winged breeding population of 941,000.

Gary Waggener, TPWD assistant dove program leader in Edinburg, said the Valley has about a 20% increase in breeding population but nesting was off in the summer.

The mourning dove population index increased about 8.6% from last year and is about 23% above the 20 year average. The largest increase was in the south zone, 21.6% with the

central zone increasing about 11.5% and the north zone decreased by 4.4%.

Mourning dove season opened Sept. 1 and runs through Nov. 9 in the north zone; Sept. 1 - Oct. 31 and Dec. 26 - Jan. 3 in the central zone; and in the south zone, Sept. 24 - Nov. 14 and Dec. 26 - Jan. 12.

The statewide bag limit is 12 doves, including no more than six white-wings and two whitties; except for Cameron, Hidalgo, Starr and Wilcox counties where the limit is 12 with no more than two white-wings and two whitties per day.

To hunt white-winged doves, hunters must have a valid Texas hunting license and a white-winged dove stamp, \$7.

David Lobprides, TPWD assistant waterfowl program leader in Wharton, said the breeding duck survey indicated the total population at 3.2 million, down from 4.2 million last year. However the survey is conducted in the northern U.S. and Canada, and with a wet spring many teal nested farther south.

"The fall flight should be fairly similar to last year. There are a fair number of teal nesting on the Texas coast and high plains," Lobprides noted.

Blue-winged, green-winged and cinnamon teal may be hunted Sept. 11-19 with a daily bag limit of four teal, eight in possession.

Rails may be hunted Sept. 1-Nov. 9 with a daily bag limit to 15 for King and clapper rails and 25 daily for Sora and Virginia rails.

The season for all species of gallinules (common moorhen and purple gallinule) is Sept. 1-Nov. 9. Shooting hours for all early season migratory game birds is one half hour before sunrise to sunset, except during the special white-winged dove season when the shooting hours are noon to sunset.

To hunt teal, hunters must possess a valid Texas hunting license, Texas waterfowl stamp, \$7, and federal waterfowl stamp, \$15. Teal may be hunted only with steel shot.
