We support NAFTA

Dear Editor:

Our company hereby affirms our support for the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) and urges its passage by the U.S. Congress.

Since Mexico began liberalizing its trade policies in 1987, we have witnessed a phenomenal 178% increase in U.S. exports to Mexican consumers. Equally significant, the U.S. trade balance with Mexico registered a \$5.4 billion surplus in 1992; our largest single trade surplus with any nation.

The NAFTA can lock in these gains. It will remove Mexican tariffs (currently averaging two and one-half times more than their U.S. counterparts) as well as import license requirements and other tough nontariff barriers.

These developments will translate into more U.S. jobs. The current administration estimates trade with Mexico already supports over 700,000 U.S. jobs with an additional 220,000 to be created by the NAFTA. U.S. businesses, large and small, and U.S. workers stand to benefit from the free trade with Mexico.

Exports create jobs and that's what NAFTA is all about. We urge you to support the NAFTA.
