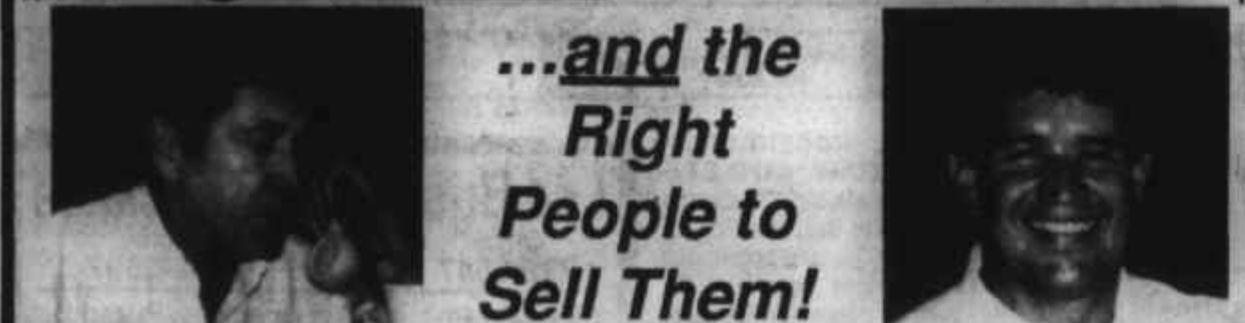

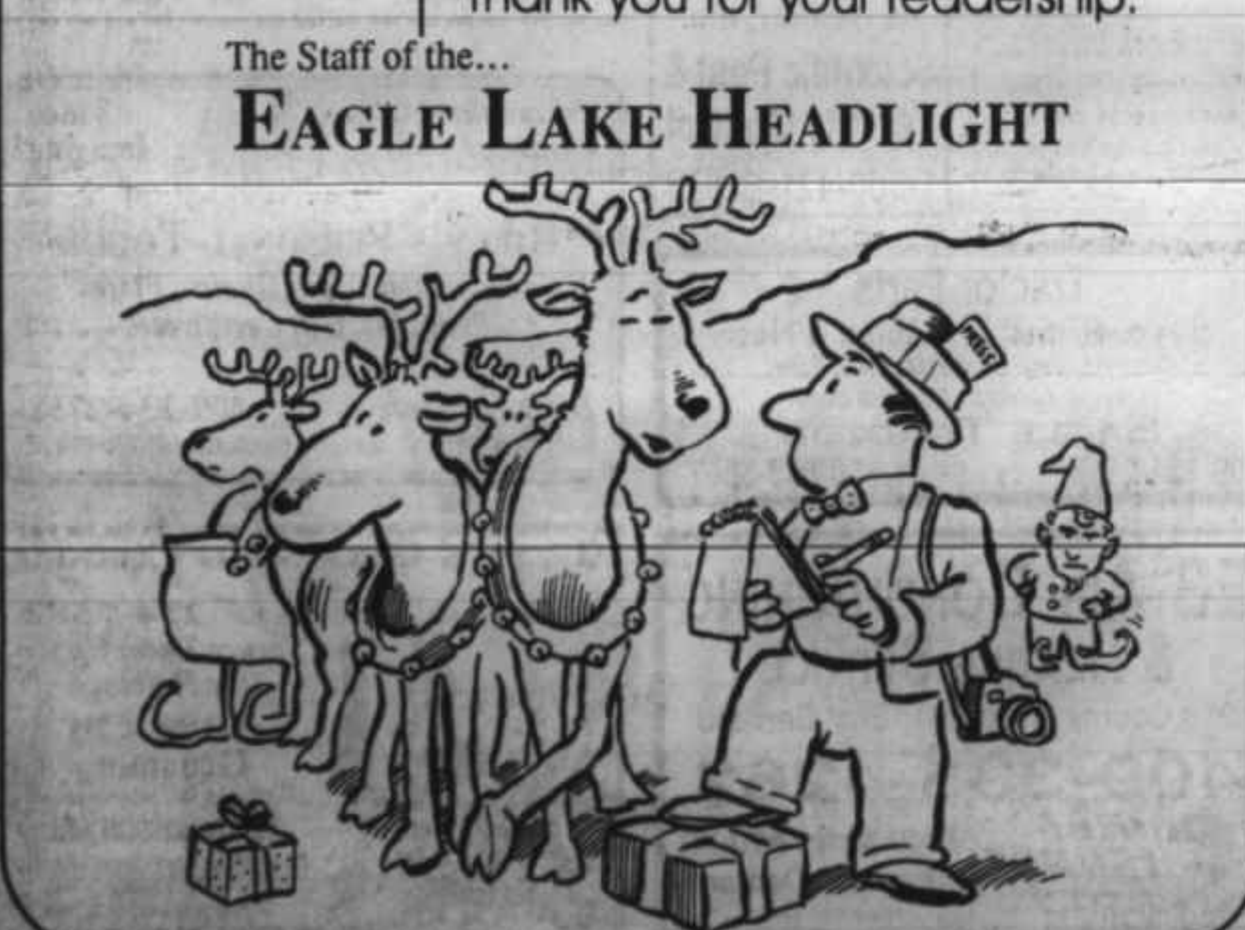

immaterial instances that were reported to the district's management in November.

The major non-compliance item was the failure of the district to spend the money required by the Texas Education Agency on state mandated programs.

The district's auditor pointed out to the board, on several occasions, that the state tells a district how much it is mandated to spend, but under funds the mandate, as was the case with RCISD. The district's corrective action will be to spend more money in the mandated area as the state makes funds available to the district.

According to the report, all problem disclosures for 1992 have been corrected with the exception of a continuing problem in the bookkeeping area, especially in the recording of

expenditures to the proper period. The district will continue to take corrective actions on this disclosure.

The report states, "...overall supervision and control over the general ledger is weak. There is difficulty noted with respect to the accounting for federal programs."

The audit compliments the management on a well run school district and a sound financial position.

The board learned of a new ruling, to take effect in 1994, which requires that all funds be expended in the month they are accrued rather than deferred to another month. This ruling will affect local budgets.

Beginning school year expenses if accrued in August must come out of the already prepared budget which ends Aug. 31, instead of being deferred until September, as has been

done historically.

As a result, districts are being encouraged to change their budget years to end June 30. The possibility of a later starting date is the solution being taken by some Texas school districts.

The board learned from Assistant Superintendent Fred Grahmann that the foam roofing applied to a portion of the Eagle Lake Middle School several years ago is defective. The repair was approved contingent upon a warranty agreement being obtained from the company and Maintenance Director A.D. Fudge being on the site as the foam is applied for the second time.

In other business, the board:

• Approved the district's textbook committee;

• Approved a right-of-way easement with San Bernard Electric Co. for a new line to be laid for the high school and administration building;

• Approved a waiver of taxes as requested by the Eagle Lake Youth Council Inc.;

• Appointed Madison Smith of Garwood as a Colorado County Central Appraisal District board member, replacing Albert Leopold;

• Approved JaNette Etheridge, Jana Birmingham, Suzanne Corman, Christine Hruzek and Geraldine Saha as substitute teachers;

• Approved expenses for adjudicated juveniles at the Alternative Education Program's learning center in the amount of \$15,000, along with funds for increased staffing, supplies and alternative behavior management training for the staff at the center; and

• Presented board member Sam Center with a certificate of appreciation for the hunting trip he organized for boys at Rice High School.

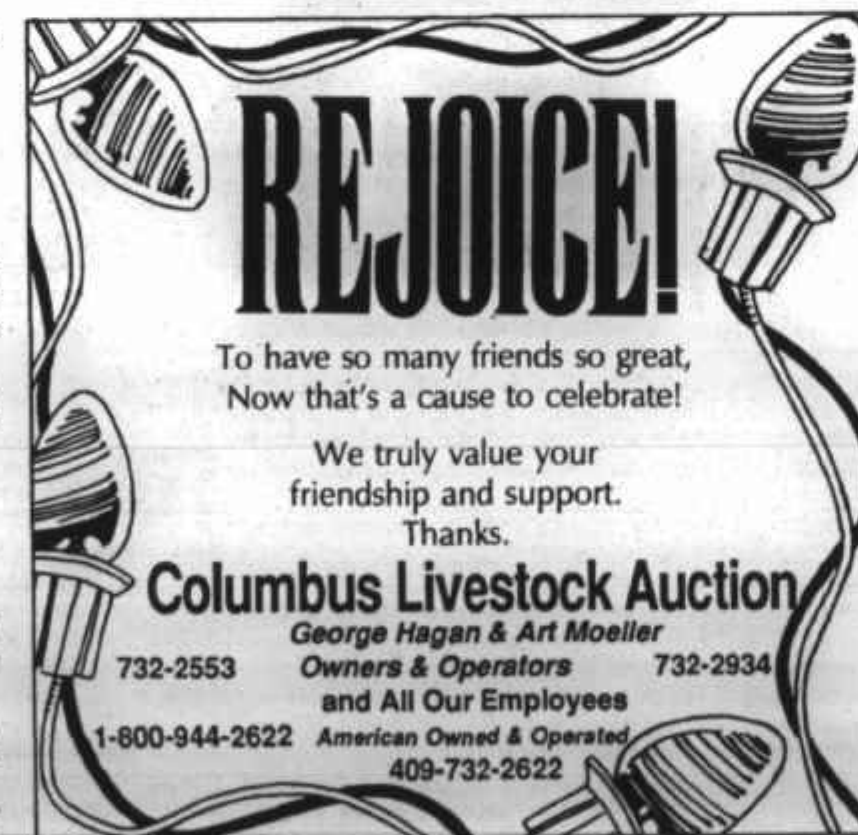
The approval of this action will allow the dogs to be available for emergency calls.

Present restrictions do not allow police vehicles to be taken out of the city except on official business.

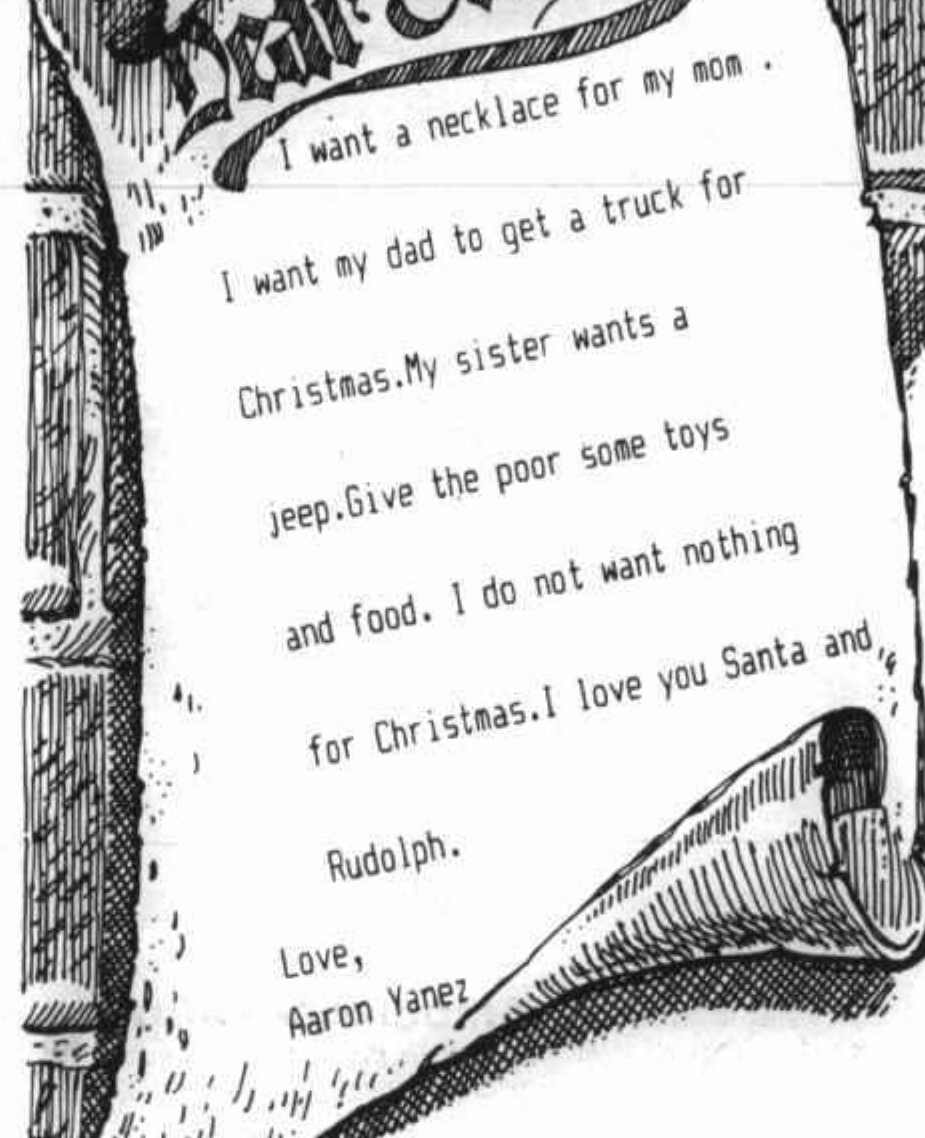
Council was adamant that the car be driven directly to and from the officer's residence only, and only on his days off. The officer maintains an apartment in Eagle Lake during his work week.
