Main, Eagle Lake, Texas 77434 until 2:00 P.M., January 18, 1994, when they will be opened and read aloud for furnishing all plant, labor, materials and equipment and performing all work required for the construction of the 1993 0.75 Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion, hereinafter termed "Owner".
