Feds sue Barnes, Connally for 1985 illegal loans

Former Lt. Governor Ben Barnes and former Gov. John Connally's son, Mark, were named in a civil lawsuit filed by federal prosecutors last week that alleges the two men illegally secured three loans for about \$2.5 million in 1985 from a now-defunct savings and loan.

The government is not charging Mr. Connally and Mr. Barnes with a crime, but the statute we are now using can be an effective tool in bank fraud-related cases," said assistant U.S. Attorney Michael Schwartz.
