## Raiders beat Hempstead, La Grange in district action

The Rice Raiders continued to run over their opposition in district action this week beating Hempstead 91-86, Jan. 11 then carrying their victory to La Grange with a 63-51 win Jan. 14.

The varsity boys started off with a strong offensive effort against Hempstead, putting in 23 points in the first quarter of play. They continued to stay out in front throughout the game in spite of a surge in the final period by the Hempstead team.

Brad Gohlke led the scoring with 19 points followed by Antrone Clark with 18, Ernest Sims with 13, and Darian Barrow and Jerome Haynes with 11 each.

Adding to the high score were Louis Barrow with 10, Jason Brunner with 6 and Sam Mader with 4. Brandon Mathis contributed several assists and a strong defense to help the Raiders win.

The Raiders again opened with an aggressive showing in La Grange dropping in 13 points in the first quarter and another 16 in the second. They went into the second half with a solid lead which they maintained.

D. Barrow led the scoring with 21 points. Clark made 18, L. Barrow made 12, Sims and Haynes each put in 4, and Gohlke and Mader contributed 2 each.

These victories put the Raiders' record at 4-0 for district and 17-6 for the season. They take on Columbus Tuesday and on Friday, Jan. 21, they host Bellville with the varsity playing at 7:30 p.m.
