Water heaters are surpassed only by furnaces and air conditioners when it comes to home energy efficiency according to Entex representative Betsy Glaizer of Eagle Lake. Choosing a water heater that's efficient and the proper size for your needs can make a big difference in utility bills.

Under federal law all manufacturers are required to produce water heaters that meet or exceed the mandated requirements of the National Appliance Energy Conservation Act of 1987.

These higher efficiency appliances contain improved insulation, more efficient burner systems and heat transfer technology as well as refined fire baffles. The cost is slightly higher than earlier models but the lower operating costs and fuel savings from natural gas water heaters will quickly make up the difference, Glaizer explained.

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) requires manufacturers to put

the "EnergyGuide" label on all water heaters. The large yellow label can help consumers compare value and determine which model will operate the most economically. The guide also shows how to compute annual operating costs using local utility rates.

Water heaters also carry a "first hour rating" which tells the consumer how much hot water the unit can supply in a one hour period of its start-up. A full tank of hot water.

For example, a 50 gallon gas water heater may have a first hour rating of 67 gallons.

The following list of a household's average hot water requirements can help estimate your usage needs: shower, 10-15 gallons per three minutes; bath, 15-20 gallons; dishwasher, 10-12; clothes washer with cold rinse, 10-12; hand dishwash, 4 gallons; shaving, 2; food preparation, 5; hand and face wash, 2; and house cleaning, 5-12 gallons.

Estimate the total gallons of hot water needed during the hour of the day when the household use is at its highest. Then look for a water heater with a first hour rating that matches your usage.

Gas water heaters come in 20 to 50 gallon tank sizes. Some newer models have a power venting system which allows installation through a side wall as far as 40 feet from the water heater.

Particularly suited for smaller homes are the tankless water heaters that do not store water but heat it as it's needed.

Stocker Cows: good stocker cows & heifers, \$675-750; medium stocker cows & heifers, \$475-625; good cow & calf pairs, \$825-990 pr.; medium cow & calf pairs, \$675-800 pr.; common cow & calf pairs, \$550-650 pr. Where your livestock brings top \$ every time.

Cattle on hand: 890; sheep and goats, 2; horses, 3.

Packer Cows: higher dressing utility and cutter cows, 49-54¢ per lb.; lower dressing utility and cutter cows, 43-47¢; light weight canner cows, 36-41¢.

Packer Bulls: heavy weight bulls, 60-65¢ per lb.; utility and cutter bulls, 55-58¢; light weight canner

bulls, 48-55¢.

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
