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WIC offers nutrition for mothers, children

Many Austin, Waller and Colorado County families can benefit from nutrition education and free food through the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) Program.
The program is a special supplement food program that provides information and vouchers for foods rich in calcium, iron and protein for pregnant and breastfeeding women, babies and children under five years of age.
In addition to nutritional help, all infants and children who receive help at the clinic and their siblings can receive free immunization shots there.
Many families who do not qualify for other types of aid will be eligible for the WIC program. People receiving Medicaid, food stamps and AFDC can also qualify.
The Columbus WIC office is located at 502 Washington St. The clinic is open Thursday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., and the second and fourth Tuesday.
The team also travels to Eagle Lake, Weimar and Prairie View.

Take a four-day tour of Texas at San Antonio Folklife Festival

In a state as big as Texas there are so many things to do, see and learn during a regular vacation.
Because Texas covers 275,000 square miles it is large enough to contain 15 of the 50 states within its borders with 1,000 square miles left over. It could take months to absorb it all. Since most folks only have a few days for their vacation it is an awesome project. However, there is a way to see, taste and experience the entire Lone Star State in just one vacation destination: the Texas Folklife Festival in San Antonio.
This year's festival will be held Thursday through Sunday, Aug. 4-7. It is presented and produced by the Institute for Texas Cultures in San Antonio. The 23rd annual Texas Folklife Festival will not only give visitors a tour of the state but a tour of over 25 countries of the world, all in just four days.
General Information
Tickets in advance to the Texas Folklife Festival are \$6 for adults and \$1 for children, six to 12. At the gate they are \$8 and \$2. Children under six are free.
Thursday, Aug. 4, is Seniors' Night when those over 65 get in for \$4 at the gate. Sunday, Aug. 7, is Kids' Day when children under 12 get in for free with a paying adult.
Groups of 20 or more adults may purchase in advance for \$5 each. The festival will be open Aug. 4 and 5 from 5 to 11 p.m.; Saturday, Aug. 6, from noon to 12 p.m.; and Sunday, noon to 9 p.m.

The festival is presented by the University of Texas Institute for Texas Cultures at San Antonio on the institute grounds in downtown San Antonio as an extension of its state-wide educational center.

Each year, some 70,000 visitors enjoy the enthusiasm and willingness to share by musicians, dancers, cooks, bakers, craftspeople and historians. This ideal vacation spot includes entertainment, food and education about the state's unique heritage.

Music and Dance
Lovers of music and dance will not be disappointed. The festival features some of the most talented, gifted entertainers in Texas. If you're tired of the usual Tejano, blues, rock and roll or country songs, enjoy something different. There are 11 stages with ethnic and historical entertainment going on all day every day.
Jam to the sounds of Houston's Bayou City Antic Singers, Grand Prairie's musical saw musician, Robert Froehner or gospel music in the Brush Arbor. There are German bands, country-western, Cajun and Celtic groups performing on various stages. And the San Antonio Scottish Pipes & Drums parade through the grounds.

Food, Food, Food
After you have been dazzled by dance and charmed by the music, wander through the various areas of the festival grounds and taste Texas varied cultures. There are offerings of such foods as the Dutch tulip onions, Turkish baks, Filipino pancit and Danishebleskivers.
Or enjoy the well known Texas specialties such as chili, chicken fried steak, barbecue ribs and great Texas barbecue.

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
