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Search is on for Rice CISD superintendent

The board of trustees for the Rice Consolidated Independent School District is preparing to find a new superintendent.

The board held a workshop Friday, Sept. 16, to finalize plans for the superintendent search process. All board members attended.

The primary concern, according to the trustees, is to create as much community involvement in the selection process as possible. The board had already set dates for public forums in each community of the district to gather input on the superintendent selection.

The first forum, in Eagle Lake last Thursday, the evening before the workshop, had sparse attendance due to short notice, but was very productive. Trustees were pleased with the input and suggestions they received from citizens.

The second forum was to be Wednesday, Sept. 21, at Sheridan School cafeteria beginning at 7 p.m. and the remaining forum will be at Garwood School on Monday, Sept. 26.

Applications will be taken through Oct. 1.

On Oct. 5, the board will review applications and screen candidates. They plan to select eight candidates for interviews.

The interviews will be conducted Friday, Oct. 14, and Saturday, Oct. 15. The interview committee is made up of two board members, Jack Vawter and Jim Wiese, community and staff representatives.

Board President Melody Grigar will organize and conduct the interview process but will not be a voting member of the committee.

The community and staff representatives will be selected by the site based, decision making committee of each campus. The total committee will select three or four finalists for the position.

These candidates will be interviewed Oct. 21 by the entire board of trustees.

The board's final selection will undergo an indepth background check by a board committee. The chosen committee will travel to the candidate's current community to interview coworkers, community members and others.

The board hopes to complete the search process and make the final selection by Nov. 1.

Citizens are reminded to attend the remaining forum at Garwood School on Monday, Sept. 26. They may give suggestions and ask questions about the superintendent selection process at the forum.

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City Council asked to help with Dunham Environmental project

Richard "Dick" Dunham asked the Eagle Lake City Council for its support and participation in the Dunham Environmental Medical Waste Incinerator Project at its last meeting.

However, Council agreed to study the request before taking action.

The Colorado County Industrial Corporation has authorized the bond issue to finance the project and Dunham asked the City to participate in the project by holding title to the land and leasing it back to Dunham Environmental until the bonds are paid off.

Statutes require that in order to have tax-free bonds, a government entity must own the land. Dunham assured Council that there would in no way be any financial obligation to the City, either now or in the future.

Dunham used a scale model with working parts to demonstrate and answer questions about the operation and safety of the medical waste incinerator.

Former Mayor Don Bendy told the group the project began four years ago after the project presentation encountered opposition in the City of El Campo. At that time, Bendy contacted Dunham about locating in Eagle Lake.

According to Bendy, the project was viewed by the Industrial Foundation Executive Committee and Board of Directors as well as certain responsible citizens.

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The Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) was then called in to analyze the operation. It also furnished positive feedback on the incinerator project and a public hearing was held.

"I'm in favor of industrial and economic development, but not at all cost. Some I don't want, but I believe this is one that we do want," said Bendy. "They're here because I called them."

The incinerator, which will be located north of Eagle Concrete Inc. and continue to Hubbard Ferry Road, has received its state permits and is expected to begin construction by Nov.

Dunham introduced Lee Middleton, who will be the plant supervisor, to Council. Middleton's and Dunham's wives were also present.

According to Dunham, the project price tag was originally \$3.5 million. "Due to safety and state regulations and our always trying to make a better system, we are now looking at an \$8 million operation," said Dunham.

Council approved an ordinance setting the 1994 tax rate at \$3.9734 per \$100 valuation. A public hearing was conducted on Aug. 30. Since the rate,

which was subject to rollback, received no opposition at that time, it was adopted.

A resolution establishing guidelines and criteria for granting tax abatement in a reinvestment zone created in Colorado County was approved.

The resolution has already been adopted by the Colorado County Commissioners' Court, Cities of Weimar and Columbus, Columbus and Weimar Independent School Districts and Glidden Water District. The Rice Consolidated Independent School District chose not to renew its abatement program.

Bendy, Bill Harrison Jr. and Mayor Robby Cook will meet with the Rice board at its Oct. meeting to discuss the tax abatement program for economic development in Colorado County.

City Manager Ron Holland told Council that "tax abatements are a very necessary tool in economic development and I recommend council continue to participate in the program."

In other business, Council approved a request by the Shriners to conduct fund-raising in Eagle Lake on Saturday, Oct. 1.

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
