

Head lice are tiny, wingless insects that reside on the scalp and hair of umans (mostly children). Lice live off the blood they suck from bites to the scalp. Outbreaks are common in schools and day care centers. Bites and fecal deposits from head lice may cause itching of the scalp.

become attached to hair follicles. Effective treatment of head lice involves killing the lice as well as eggs attached to the hair. According to the Handbook of Nonprescription Drugs, the medicine of choice for treating head lice in adults and children is 1% permethrin cream rinse. Before applying the rinse, shampoo the hair with regular shampoo. Rinse the hair before applying permethrin. Let the rinse remain on the scalp for 10 minutes. Rinse and dry the hair again. Remove lice eggs and egg shells from the hair with the special comb provided.
