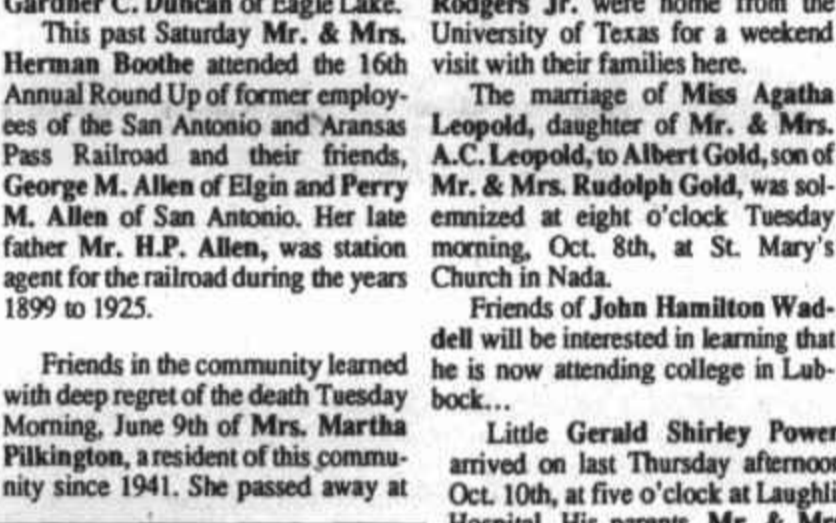
Former resident beats physician's forecast

Schwemm delivers 'pep talk' at banquet

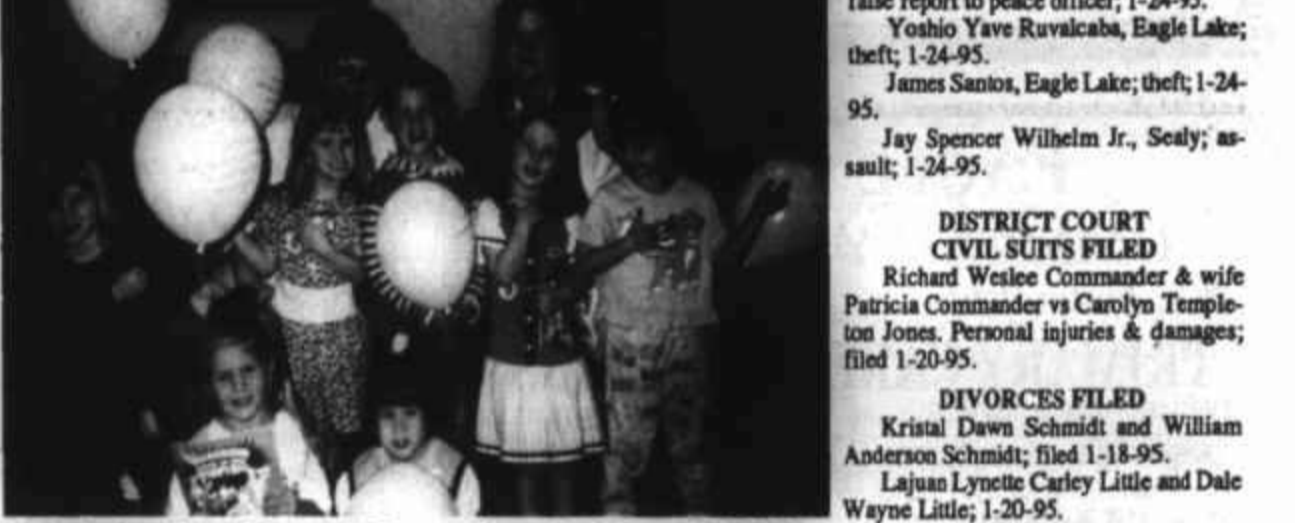
