USDA farm loans require insurance

Any producer who anticipates applying for a farm loan from USDA must obtain at least Catastrophic (CAT) crop insurance coverage on all crops of economic significance. This coverage must be obtained before the sales closing date for the producer's particular crops.
The requirement applies to both direct and guaranteed farm ownership, operating or emergency loans administered by the former Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) offices, now using the working name Rural Economic and Community Development (RECD).

Migration of birds: Nature's mystery

Every fall ducks, geese and cranes fly south from Canada to Texas and other points south only to return to Canada and points north in the spring to raise their young.
Songbirds, also called neotropical migrants, travel to and from nesting habitat in the United States and Canada to neo-tropical habitats ranging from Mexico to Argentina.
This activity is called "bird migration," one of nature's best known, yet least understood phenomena. Why do these birds go through this very energy expensive process twice every year? No one really knows for sure.

Laughlin fights Social Security number fraud

Congressman Greg Laughlin has co-sponsored the Social Security Number Anti-Fraud Act in an effort to help states and the federal government ease the burden of services to illegal aliens.
The bill provides a "1-800" number employers can call to receive instant verification of a potential employee's Social Security Account, making it almost impossible for illegal aliens to obtain employment and eliminating an incentive for entering the U.S. illegally.
According to a study by the Immigration and Naturalization Service, most illegal aliens arrive legally but overstay their visas for employment. The new system is expected to cost an estimated \$3 billion.
However, in California alone, they spent almost \$3 billion in services to illegal aliens.
