Foot Facts

BABY YOUR CHILD'S FEET

Even before children are old enough to use their feet for little more than waving in the air, parents should give some thought to foot care. To allow muscles to develop, a baby should never be bundled so tightly that feet are restricted from moving freely. Also, use baby walkers and jumpers with caution. Early overuse of walkers may cause muscles in the back of the leg to shorten, and walkers have been associated with a variety of injuries. When letting the child bounce in a jumper, place something soft, such as an exercise mat, under the foot to avoid stressing bones. Use bathing or changing time to watch for signs of foot trouble, including growth, swelling, discoloration, or tenderness.

Rookies drop two to league-leading Clippers

The Rice Rookies traveled to Shiner Sunday afternoon to take on the Clippers who came in with a 2-0 record after sweeping the Bernardo Bears last week. The Rookies went to bat with a 1-1 record after splitting the Victoria Gunslingers last week.

The pitching was given to Greg Carrera for game 1 against the hard-hitting Clippers. Greg held them to two runs in three innings before handing over the pitching duties to Aaron Machac because of a pulled muscle. Greg was very effective giving up only one hit. He managed to strike out two batters and allowed four base on balls.

Aaron came in to relieve in the fourth inning. He also held the scrappy Shiner bunch to a minimum. Aaron pitched three innings, allowed only two hits, struck out three and walked only one.

Once again the death of the Rookies was due to the silent bats. They collected only four hits, two of them from the bat of Matt Faldyn. He solo homered in the fourth inning and later ripped a single with another RBI in the sixth.

The Rookies fell short 4-2 in game 1 of the double header.

Again, the Rice team proved to be solid defensively, committing no errors in the game.

Damon Massey took the mound for game 2 and pitched the entire game, with exception to one batter. He battled the Clippers hard with five strike-outs, eight hits and four walks. He held the clean-up batter, probably the strongest hitter in the South Central Texas Amateur League, hitless and struck him out twice.

Damon held Shiner to two runs through five innings. They exploded for seven runs in the bottom of the sixth with the help of two Rookie errors.

The Clippers definitely showed depth in the pitching department. They again held the Rookies to only four hits. Three of the four hits were from the bat of Greg Carrera. Greg had three singles. His only other time to the plate, Greg layed down a beautiful sacrifice bunt, moving the runner into scoring position.

The Rookies lost the second game 9-2.

They will host Flatonia Saturday night at Rice High School field. The first game is to start at 6 p.m.

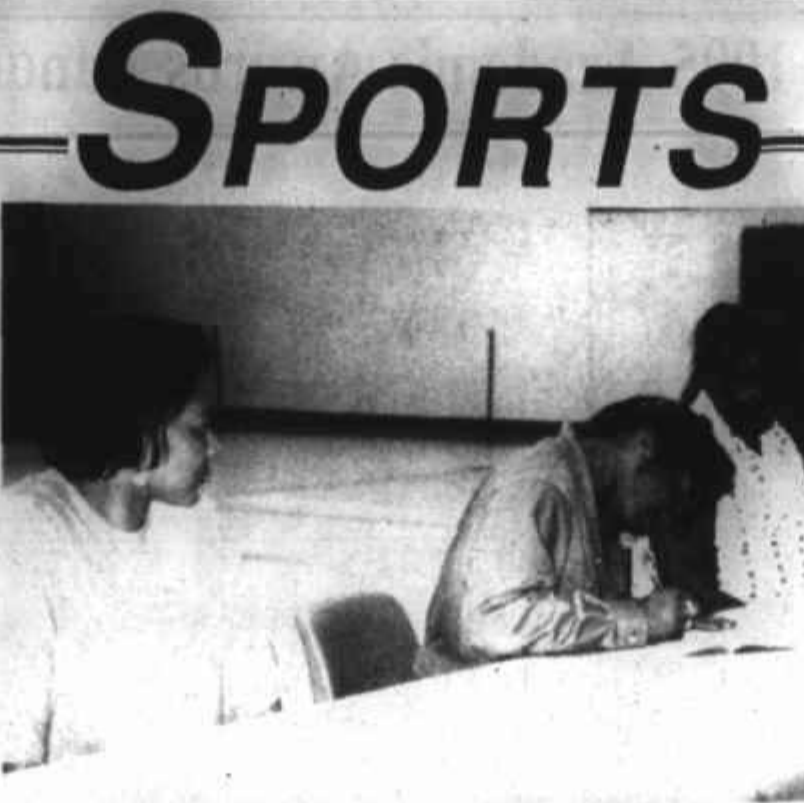


Kelly is graduating from Rice High School and we wish her the best of luck in her future endeavors.


