Orthotics. An orthotic laboratory uses the casts to fashion corrective devices, generally of high-impact materials such as plastic or super-strong woven fibers. Padding and built-up areas are designed into the orthotics to accommodate special needs. When slipped into shoes, orthotics guide the patient's foot into the correct position to function normally, without strain or pain.
