Rookies end season with two losses

The Rice Rookies hosted the Flonita Wildcats in two scoring games on Sunday, July 9, beginning at 2 p.m. at Raider field. The games were rescheduled from a May 27 rain out. After playing a doubleheader against Weimar on the previous Saturday, the blistering summer heat took its toll on the Rookies.

Ernest Sims was assigned pitching duties for the Rookies in the 4-1 loss in game 1 of the matchup.

After giving up four runs on three hits in the first three innings, Sims and the Rookie defense held the Wildcats scoreless and hitless in the remaining four innings. Sims had two strikeouts, walked seven batters and hit one with a wild pitch during the seven inning game.

Although the Rookie bats produced more hits than Flonita's, Rice was only able to cross the plate once when Tweet Ford, who doubled to reach base in the bottom of the sixth inning, was driven in by a single off the bat of Matt Faldyn.

Other contributing Rookies were Joel Grigar, who doubled, then singled, his first two at-bats, and Phillip Krampitz, who singled in the seventh.

The Wildcats proved to be mightier than Rice in the second game of the contest and the Rookies dropped the game to Flonita in a six inning duel that ended 11-2.

Starting on the hill for the Rookies was Krampitz. Through four and one-third innings, he gave up 11 runs on seven hits, walked five, struck out one and hit two batters.

Krampitz was relieved by Grigar, who turned in a fine performance, although too late for the Rookies to recover from Flonita's early barrage. Through his one and two-thirds innings, Grigar gave up no runs on no hits, with one strikeout and one walk.

The Rookie offense was unable to muster a lot of firepower and was held to just two runs coming off six hits.

The first Rookie run was scored in the first inning after Jerry Sims led off with a double, followed by a Grigar single and an RBI double by Aaron Machac.

After a second inning shut out, K. Sims again led off with a single in the third and Machac scored the only additional Rookie run on a Tweet Ford single after reaching on a fielders choice.

Krampitz added a single in the fourth and Grigar a double in the fifth for the only additional Rookie hits.

The Rookies completed their season with an 8-12 record after the La Grange Demons were forced to forfeit their last two scheduled games on July 15.

The Rookie organization wished to thank everyone who supported them throughout the season, and asks for continued support in the coming season.

following these common-sense guidelines:

- Be leery of anyone who appears at your door uninvited — or worse, who comes by after you have told him or her you are not interested. You have the right not to let any salesperson enter your home. If a salesperson comes in your home and will not leave, call 911.
- Check out people who offer to talk to you or your group. Scrutinize their credentials carefully. The salesperson in Killeen boasted of degrees from Texas A&M and the University of Mississippi — neither checked out.
- Don't pay unless you have a contract. Don't be rushed into signing. Read any contract carefully and never sign one that has blank spaces on it.
- Lastly, if you get an unsolicited sales pitch, keep in mind that they contacted you. It is your right to turn down their offer. If you are not interested, hang up the phone, close the door or throw away the mail.

If you are suspicious or unhappy about an offer, call the police or report it to your local Better Business Bureau or our nearest regional Consumer Protection Office.
