Hunting, fishing license sales to go high tech

Texas Parks and Wildlife Department has signed a five-year contract with a Texas technology company to implement an electronic system designed to make the issuance of hunting and fishing licenses and stamps easier, quicker and more reliable. Plans call for the computerized system to be field tested at 13 pilot sites this Nov.

Texas is among a handful of states looking to join Oregon and Michigan as the first to operate an electronic hunting and fishing licensing system. TPWD sells approximately 3.5 million hunting and fishing licenses annually through its 28 district offices. Under the agreement signed recently, Transactive Corporation will design, install and maintain the electronic point-of-sale network which is expected to replace the current manual, paper-based system at more than 3,000 licensing locations throughout Texas by May 1, 1996.
