Raider varsity gets scratched by Wildcats

Our 1995 football season got off to a poor start as we came home from Welmar with a disappointing 48-21 loss.

Fumbles, poor defensive plays, and a Welmar kick-off return on the first play of the game made for a rough night.

Offensively, the Raiders looked promising; and, with more work and fewer turnovers, we should be hard to stop in future games.

Performing well for the offense was James Cotton with 180 yards on 15 carries and one touchdown. He also had 88 yards on 4 kick-off returns.

Brandon Mathis had 89 yards passing and 78 yards rushing. Rocky Banks scored a touchdown on a three yard run. He also had three kick-off returns for 77 yards.

Larry Henderson scored a touchdown on a three yard run; while Garrett Hagendorf had two pass catches for 67 yards.

Jesse Bishop made a 23 yard field goal. Defensively, the Raiders must work hard to improve their performance, according to their coaches.

The offense can help make it easier for the defense by not fumbling and leaving the other team in good field position.

Poor tackling and missed assignments led to a disappointing defensive performance Friday night. We must make adjustments to improve.

Best defensive performers were Mason Pratt with seven tackles and one assist; Billy Ray Johnson, six tackles and two assists; Tim Teague, four tackles and one assist; Kyle Fink, three tackles, three assists and a fumble recovery; James Cotton, four tackles, one assist and one interception for touchdown that was called back; and James Eaton and Brent Schneider also had a fumble recovery each.

The Raiders can't take a breather as they prepare to take on the Schulenburg Shorthorns Friday night in Schulenburg at 8 p.m.

We hope with hard work, better play and some adjustments that we can overcome the Welmar game and forget about it.

Schulenburg, as always, has a fine team and will provide tough opposition for the Raiders. We feel that we can make the adjustments and come back with a fine performance this week. Come on over to Schulenburg and support your Raiders. We can't give up on these kids now and they need to see that they have your support.
