GOUT IS A SOMETIMES THING

The good news about gout is that it can usually be controlled. The bad news is that there is no cure, and once you have had one episode of the characteristic pain and swelling, it may come and go throughout your life. Gout is a chronic disease in which crystals of uric acid (a chemical produced by the liver) settle in the kidneys and blood vessels, around tendons, and in joints, rather than being disposed of via urine. Feet, especially the big toe, often become targets of gout, perhaps due to the constant pressure of walking. Treatment may include preventive drugs, anti-inflammatory drugs, and medications that control the body's uric acid. Surgery may be an option for joints severely damaged by gout.

Many medical conditions that affect circulation (blood flow), nerves (feeling), or joints may first cause damage to your feet. That's why you should see your podiatrist regularly, especially if you have medical conditions such as gout, diabetes, arthritis, or poor circulation. Although we don't treat the underlying medical condition, we do work closely with your primary care physician to provide care and catch problems early.
