Rookies baseball begins

The Rice Rookies opened their 1996 pre-season on Saturday, April 20, in the 12th Annual Colorado River Valley Shootout tournament at Veteran's Field in Weimar. In their first game of tournament action, the Rookies experienced their first defeat of the season at the hands of the Shiner Clippers in a hard-fought 16-9 loss. Starting on the mound, and going the distance for the Rookies, was their returning ace, Damon Massey, who last year was chosen to represent the South Central Texas Amateur League at the National Baseball Congress tournament in Wichita. Massey's season debut was marred by a strong offensive barrage by the Clippers. Through six complete innings of play, Massey gave up 11 hits, allowed eight walks and struck out seven batters. The Rookies showed a lot of promise, but also displayed some first-game jitters by allowing three Clippers to reach base on costly errors, which eventually led to two runs scoring. Like Shiner, the Rookies also had a strong offensive performance, scoring their nine runs on nine hits, which were evenly dispersed among eight of the Rookie batters. After the Rookies failed to score in the first inning, Aaron Machac hit a line-drive triple into the gap in right center, driving in Darrell Quinney, Joe Trojan and Greg Carrera, who had all reached on singles. After a scoreless third, Matt Faldyn stepped up to the plate in the fourth with two out and three men on base. He blasted the first pitch to the wall, down the third baseline, scoring Troy Holcomb and Machac, who had both reached on walks. Faldyn and Kevin Gage added back-to-back doubles in the sixth and the Rookies were picking up momentum. However, they were unable to muster enough late-inning runs to compensate for the Clippers' assault, when the game was called because of time constraints at the end of the sixth. Also adding singles to the Rookies' battery were Tweet Ford and Ernest Sims. The Rookies again travel to Weimar on Saturday, April 27, where they will vie with the Flatonia Wildcats for third place in the tournament. Game time is scheduled for 5:30 p.m. The Rookies will begin their league play on Saturday, May 4, in Weimar against the Vets. Everyone is encouraged to come out and support the Rookies who always provide some really exciting baseball action.
