Raiders drop close one to Brahmas

The Raiders hosted the Brahmas' last Friday night for their final game of the year. They came away with a hard fought 20-18 loss. This game brings their season record to 1-9, 1-4 in district 20-3A.

Friday night, the Raiders had a total of 232 yards on offense, 133 yards through the air and only 99 yards rushing on 27 carries.

Pete Rangel led all rushers with 39 yards on eight carries; Warren Scott had 32 yards on 12. Kendrick Pipkins picked up 35 yards on nine runs.

Rangel was 7-10-0 passing for 108 yards; Scott completed two passes for 25 yards.

Josh Godley was Rice's leading receiver with five catches for 100 yards, including a touchdown reception. Tim Powers caught one pass for 15 yards and a touchdown. Rangel had an 18-yard reception from Scott on a pass play.

Rice had a chance to tie the game and put in overtime, but, in spite of a great effort, Rangel was stopped just short of the goal line on a two-point conversion attempt.

Defensively, Rice again played a pretty good game except for some mental breakdowns and a fine Brahmas catch with eight seconds left in the first half after Rice lost the ball in a costly turnover.

Hallettsville had 299 yards of offense, 98 on the ground, 201 in the air. Leading defensive players were:
