Rice JV falls to Bluejays, take two of three in tournament

The Rice Raider JV fell to 3-2 for the young season as the Needville Bluejays did anything and everything to the Raiders Tuesday night, Dec. 3, taking the game by a score of 76-32.

The Raiders offense and defense both appeared to still be on Thanksgiving break throughout the game. The Raiders were not only out of sync but appeared to be completely in awe of the taller Bluejays throughout the long night.

Leading the Raiders scoring "charge" were Clint Gertson and Willie Cleveland with eight points each while Kenny Pipkins collected almost half of the Raiders' 19 rebounds with nine.

Hitting only 12 of their 54 shots hurt the Raiders, but a complete lack of effort really did them in, said their coach.

"How we respond to this will determine a whole lot about the rest of the season," said Coach Russell. "We've just got to regroup and get back to playing our style of basketball."

After falling 19-12 in the first quarter, the Raiders could do little to nothing right. Besides shooting the ball terribly, the Raiders committed 25 turnovers and never got anything going at all.

"We lacked intensity, effort, and everything else we needed to stay in the game," added Russell.

The Raiders, though, are a young team and at times will be out of sync. As the season goes on and they get more comfortable with the new system, they should be a team to contend with.

On Saturday, Dec. 7, the Raiders faced the Shorthorns of Schulerburg. Willie Cleveland led the Raiders with 19 points and Pete Rangel chipped in 12. Kenny Pipkins hauled in 11 rebounds to go with his nine points.

Once again, the Raiders defense stiffened in the second half to allow the 19 point victory.

But, once again, the Raiders were dismal from the free-throw line, hitting on only 11 of 29 attempts.

On Saturday, Dec. 7, the Raiders faced the Brahmas of East Bernard for the tournament championship. The Raiders jumped out to an 18-14 lead after the first quarter only to see East Bernard gain a two-point lead at the half, 26-24.

Once again, missed free-throws were the culprit - the Raiders only connected on 2 of 7 in the quarter and six of 16 for the first half.

The Brahmas good defense and timely shooting of Brahmas Marlon Bluntson and James Hampton kept the Raiders at bay throughout the second half, finally securing the win for the hometown team, 41-52.

"Missed free-throws, missed shots in the paint and turnovers cost us a great chance to win the tournament," Coach Russell stated afterward.

"I was real pleased with the way we came back from the loss to Needville on Tuesday night - we played with a lot of intensity all three nights. But, we just didn't get the job done - mostly at the free-throw line and it came back to haunt us in the championship game," he added.

In the championship game, Godley led Rice with 14 points, Rangel had 13 and Cleveland added 12. Cleveland led the Raiders with 14 rebounds and Pipkins added seven more.

Garnier All-Tournament honors were Godley and Pipkins.

This week the Raiders play East Bernard at Rice on Tuesday. The Freshman game will begin at 5 p.m. with the JV and Varsity games to follow.

Also the Raiders go to Needville to play in a tournament on Friday and Saturday. Friday the Raiders play at the Middle School gym against Boling. Tip off is at 7 p.m. Hope to see ya'll at the game.

The team season record is 5-3.
