Varsity Raiders ride Brahmas

The Rice Raiders varsity basketball team gained a measure of revenge Tuesday night, Dec. 10, by defeating the East Bernard Brahmas 77-64 at Rice. The Brahmas had defeated Rice 61-52 on Saturday to win the East Bernard tournament.

Rice is now 6-3 for the year. Leading the way for the Raiders was Josh Godley who played an outstanding game scoring 25 points, grabbing 11 rebounds and eight steals.

Also contributing to the Raider cause was Kenny Pipkins who had 12 points and eight rebounds, Warren

Scott with 12 points (and some great defense), and Willie Cleveland who chipped in 10 points and grabbed six rebounds.

The Raiders hit the floor ready to play. They outscored, out ran and out hustled the Brahmas for the entire game.

Jumping out to a 22-9 lead at the end of the first quarter, the Raiders never really looked back. Everytime the Brahmas tried to get something going, the Raiders had an answer.

"Overall, this is the best we've looked so far - we ran the break well, we rebounded, we did everything we needed to do except we did have too many turnovers. But, other than that one thing, we really played well," said Coach Russell.

In the story printed last week in The Headlight concerning the Lady Raider chosen for All-District Volleyball, Nikki Chamberlain received credit for being top setter and it should have been Rachelle Kallina.

Kallina was the top setter with an outstanding setting record of 95% accuracy.

All three teams were scheduled to be in action last weekend.

The freshmen team traveled to Columbus for a tournament Friday and Saturday. They played Friday at 3:30 p.m. in Columbus against the Ricebirds of El Campo.
