"FSA will be sending out a newsletter with details about eligibility requirements. FSA and Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) are working together to provide assistance to interested individuals," Parr

Connie Fair, district conservationist with the NRCS, explained, "The eligibility requirements are site specific for every farm.

"Rental rates are based on soil productivity, land value and cropping history. Bid caps will be made for each county, but are unknown at this time," continued Fair.

According to both agencies, priority areas have ben designated at the national level and with each state to better address conservation and environmental issues in a planned and coordinated manner.

Priority areas in Texas include all of Bexar, Callahan, Deaf Smith, Randall, Scurry, Stonewall, Swisher, Taylor and Uvalde Counties.

Texas priority areas also include chinson, Lubbock, Motley, Oldham, Parmer, Potter and Roberts Counties.

Another important priority area in Texas is a 1,000-foot strip along the Rio Grande in Cameron, Hidalgo and Starr Counties.


