New Topical Medicine for Athlete's Foot

Athlete's foot (ringworm) is the most common skin infection caused by fungi. There are several different types of fungi capable of causing this infection, which is more common in men. Characteristic symptoms include itchy, burning, scaling lesions between the toes. In extreme cases, the infection may spread to the underside of the feet, causing blisters. The toenails may become infected, discolored, and overgrown.

This past October the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) approved the marketing of a new medicine for the treatment of athlete's foot. The new antifungal is butenafine (brand name is Mentax). This prescription-only medicine is provided by the manufacturer as a 1% topical cream. There have been reports of a 90% cure rate in persons who used the medicine once-a-day for 4 weeks. In clinical trials, the incidence of side effects was reported to be very low. According to news reports, physicians who participated in studies of butenafine have been pleased with the results. One report indicates that the medicine has been evaluated in over 1,300 persons. In January of this year, the FDA gave clearance to the manufacturer of butenafine to promote the medicine for the treatment of fungal infections of the groin.
