Sealed proposals addressed to the City Manager, Eagle Lake, Texas, for the construction of airport improvements at the Eagle Lake Municipal Airport, TxDOT CSJ No. 95-08-031 will be received at the City of Eagle Lake, 100 East Main, Eagle Lake, Texas 77434, until 10:00 A.M., May 9th, 1997, then publicly opened and read. Any bid received after closing time will be returned unopened.

In general, the work consists of the extension of Runway 17-35. The existing runway will be widened ten feet on the east side. Earthwork and associated grading, drainage, topsoiling, and hydromulching will be included. The existing runway, taxiway and apron will receive a seal coat.

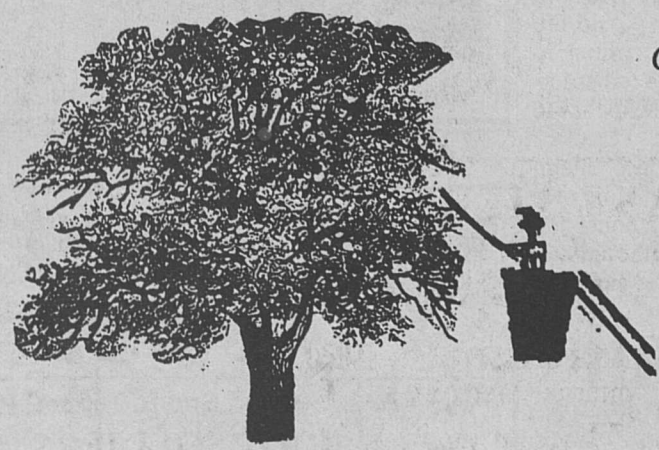
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
