Mann that the County road was, by no means, to be used by the public. A resolution to support a Texas

Capital Fund grant application, totaling \$200,000, through the Texas Dept. of Housing and Community Affairs, for the Sheridan Park and Recreation Center Inc. (SPARC) was adopted.

SPARC projects to use \$180,000 of the funds for local improvements with the \$20,000 balance going to Colorado County Economic Development Organization as administrator of

According to Jim Brisco, president of SPARC, \$40,000 will be used for water filters, \$30,000 each for sewer connection and pumps, \$25,000 for drilling and completion of a water well, \$15,000 for storm drainage improvements, \$12,000 for street improvements and \$9,000 for threephase electricity.

The Court also okayed an agreement with Hidalgo County to house 35 inmates at the Colorado County Detention Facility for \$35 per day. It is estimated that Hidalgo County will use the facility for not less than 30 days, but as long as six months.

The Court also approved the advertisement for two jailers after the above contract was approved. (See Commissioners, Page 10)
