Salutatorian

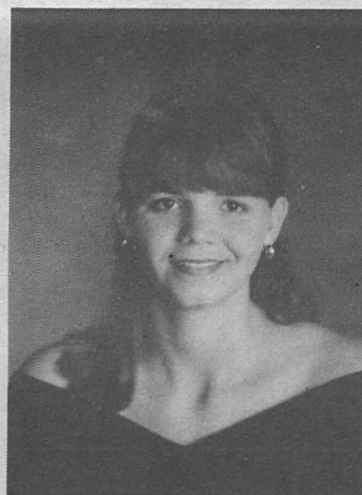
...is the daughter of David and Claudia Mann of Eagle Lake.

Following graduation from college, she plans to start a family and become a successful actress.



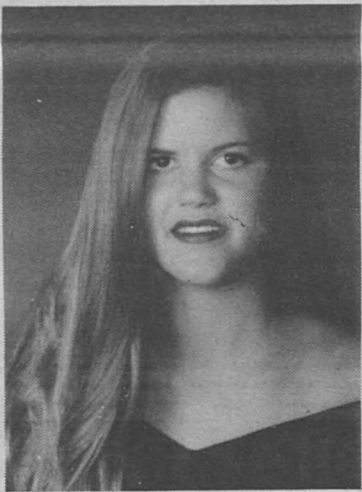
Bridget Baird

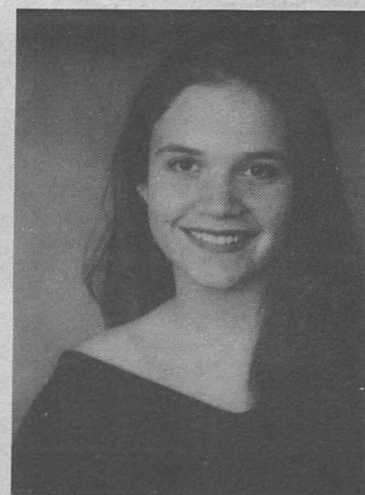
Nerrisa Brisco

Following graduation, she plans to attend the University of North Texas in Denton and major in fashion design and merchandising.

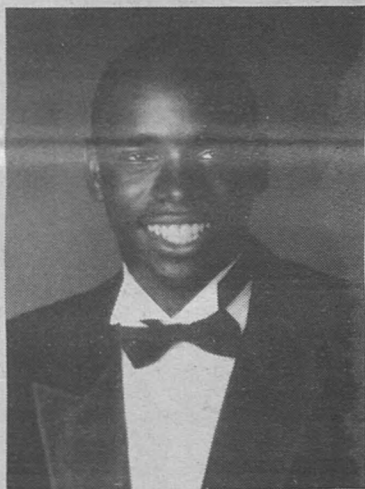


Jessica Nicole Briscoe
