

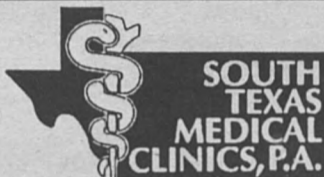

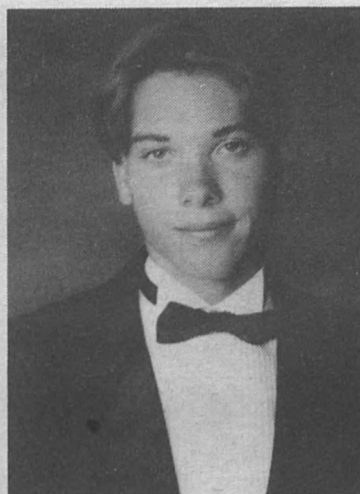

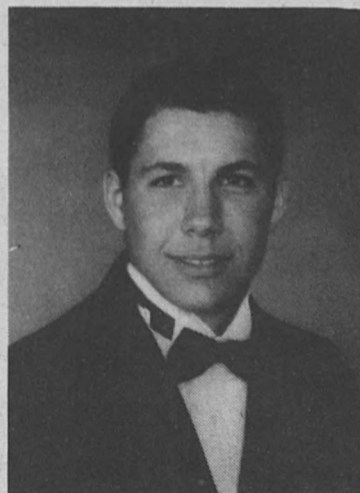

After graduation, she plans to attend Wharton County Junior College to be a computer system analyst and then transfer a major university. Later, she may enlist in the Marines.

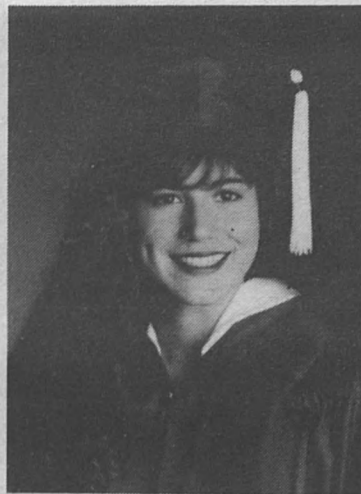


Cody Dale Cerny

Corina Nicole Chamberlain

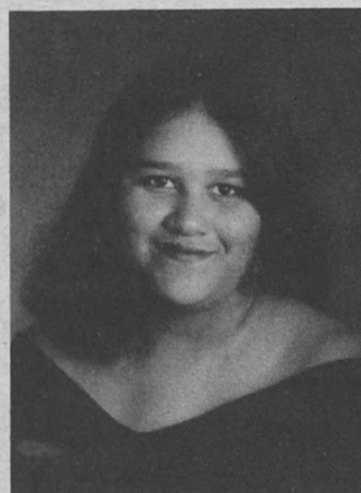
...is the daughter of Becky Chamberlain of Eagle Lake.

Adriana made the honor roll and All-Academic teams in volleyball, basketball and softball.

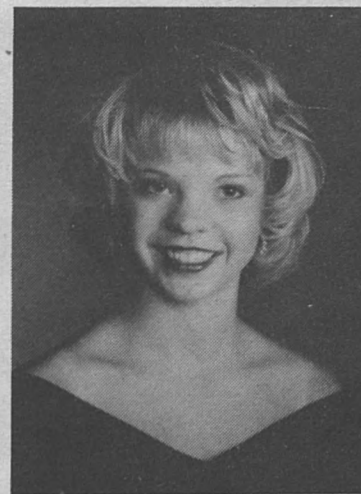
After graduation, she plans to attend Wharton County Junior College and pursue a degree in business.

Following graduation, she plans to attend Southwest Texas State University and major in education. After a few years of teaching, she would like to become a counselor. She also wants to own a travel agency.

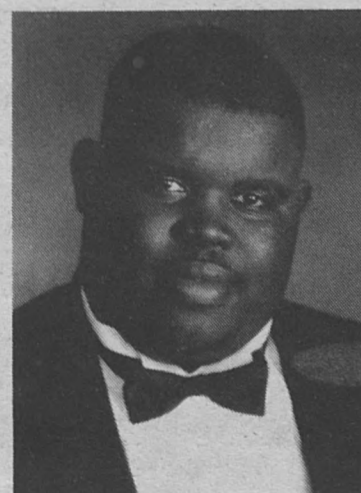


Erika LaNell Fields
