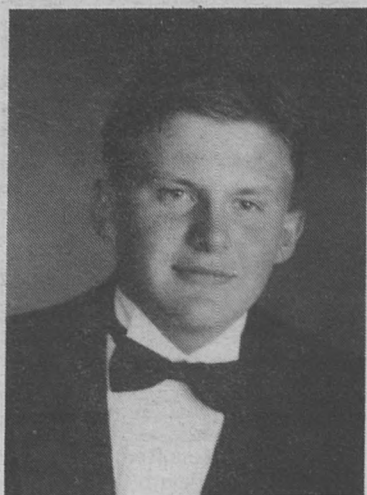


After graduation, she plans to attend Wharton County Junior College and major in nursing.

Following graduation, T.J. plans to attend a junior college and work. After college he'd like to go into law enforcement.

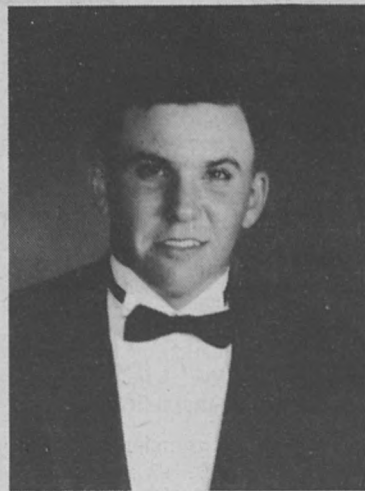


Andrea Rachelle Mahac

consumer and soil judging.

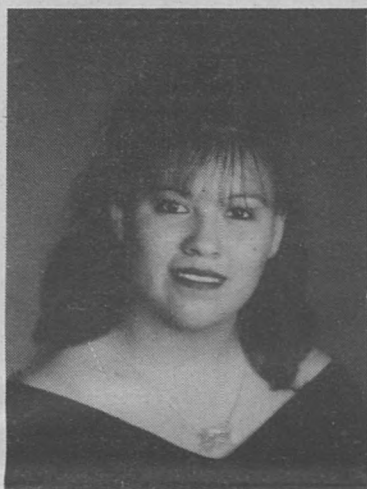
After graduation, he plans to attend Wharton County Junior College and then pursue a career in agriculture.



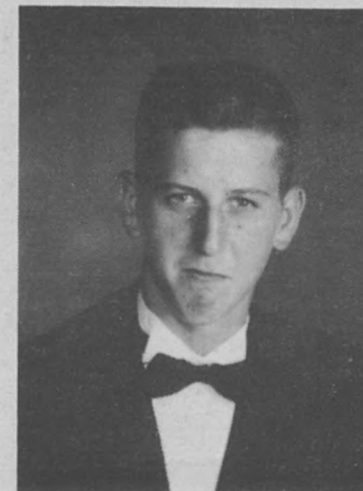
Alexis Marshall

Following graduation, she plans to attend Wharton County Junior College and major in micro computer technology.

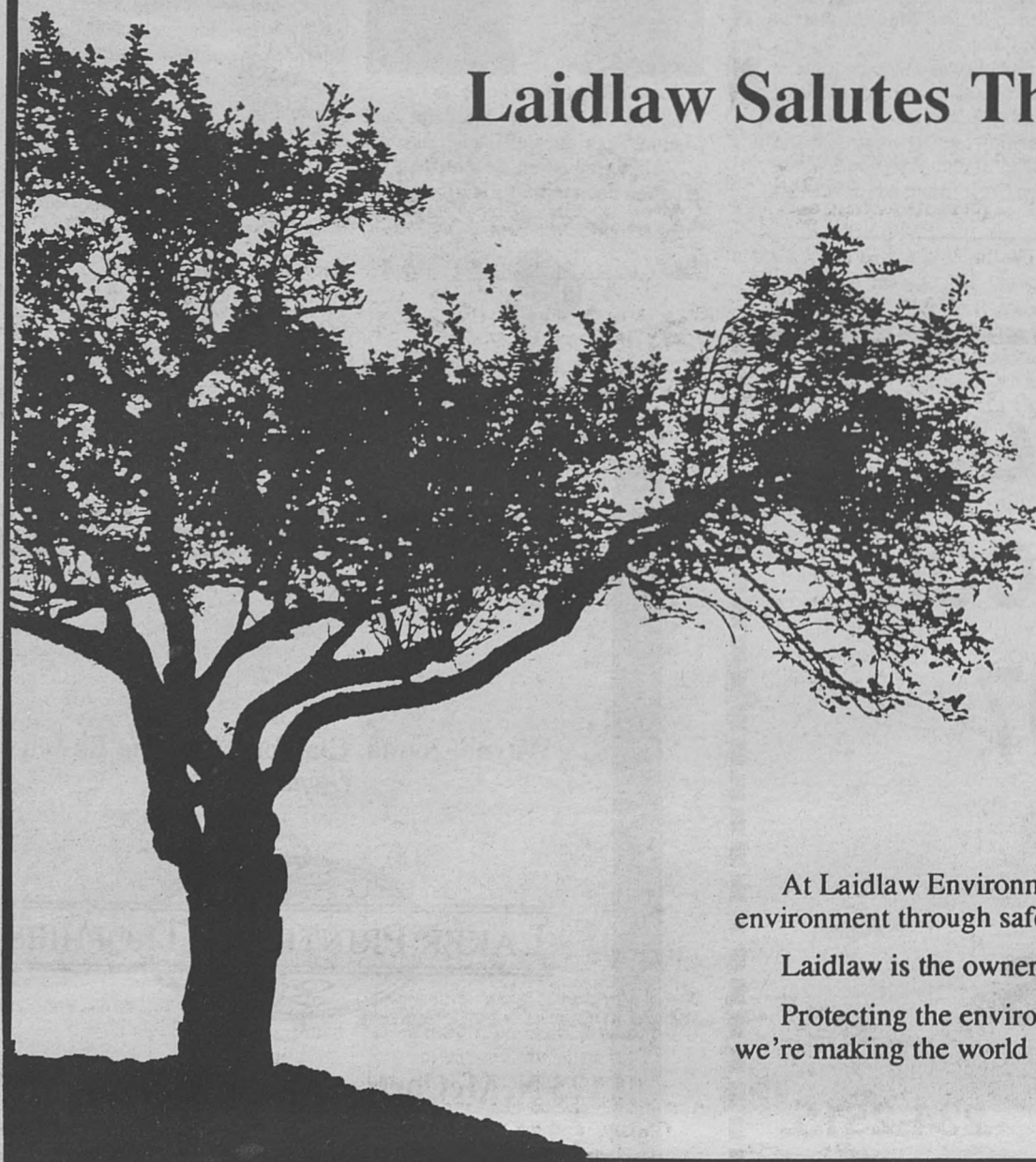


Rocio Maribel Lugo
