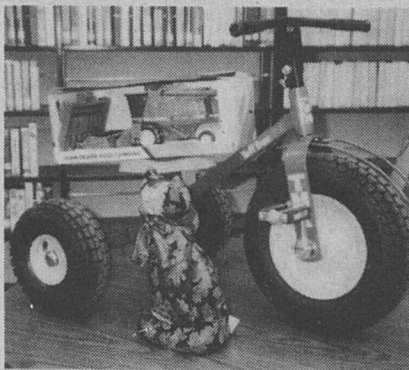




Take a look at these Study Club Auction items

Any little girl would love to have the doll and clothing ensemble pictured at right, for a gift. They were made and donated by Betty Wilcox.

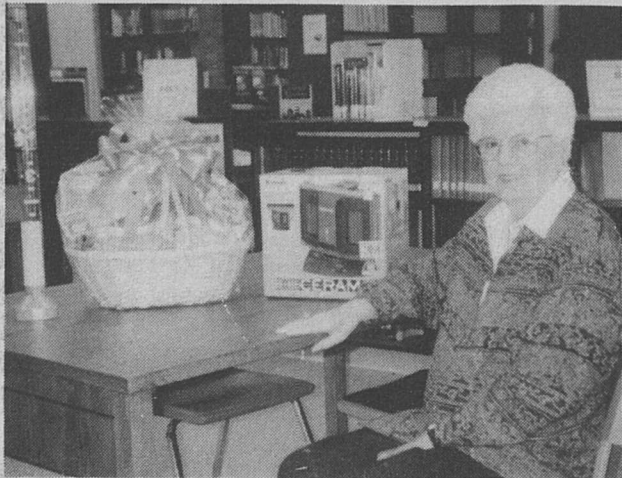
Mom or Dad would love this comfy, cozy chair shown below. It was donated by Melvin Stancik of The Furniture Shoppe in Eagle Lake.

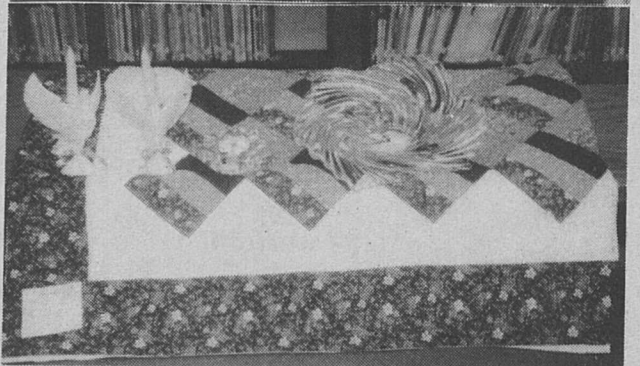
