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Repellants May Reduce Sunscreen Protection

Is it okay to apply sunscreens and insect repellants to the skin at the same time? The answer is important in certain areas of the U.S. where there is a need to protect against encephalitis, a mosquito-transmitted viral infection. According to results of a new study reported in *The Lancet*, scientists at Walter Reed Institute of Research are suggesting that the protective effect of topical sunscreens against harmful rays of the sun may be reduced by certain insect repellants. These researchers studied 14 volunteers who had applied an insect repellant in addition to a sunscreen. They evaluated the sun protection factor (SPF) of the sunscreen. Persons who used a sunscreen alone (SPF of 15) and those who applied the sunscreen along with an insect repellant were studied. Those who used both products experienced a 33 percent reduction in the sunscreen SPF. Delaying the application of the insect repellant by an hour and a half still reduced SPF values, but not by as much.

Researchers want to know why SPF values decreased. One possibility is that the active ingredient in many repellants, *diethyltoluamide*, may disrupt the protective layer provided by the sunscreen. When sunscreens and insect repellants are applied together, extra precaution may be needed, such as avoiding outdoors during hours when sunlight is most direct (10AM-2PM).
