I am asking voters in Colorado County Precinct 4 for their support in the Nov. election in 1998. A Commissioner's task is very important and I am a strong believer in common sense government.

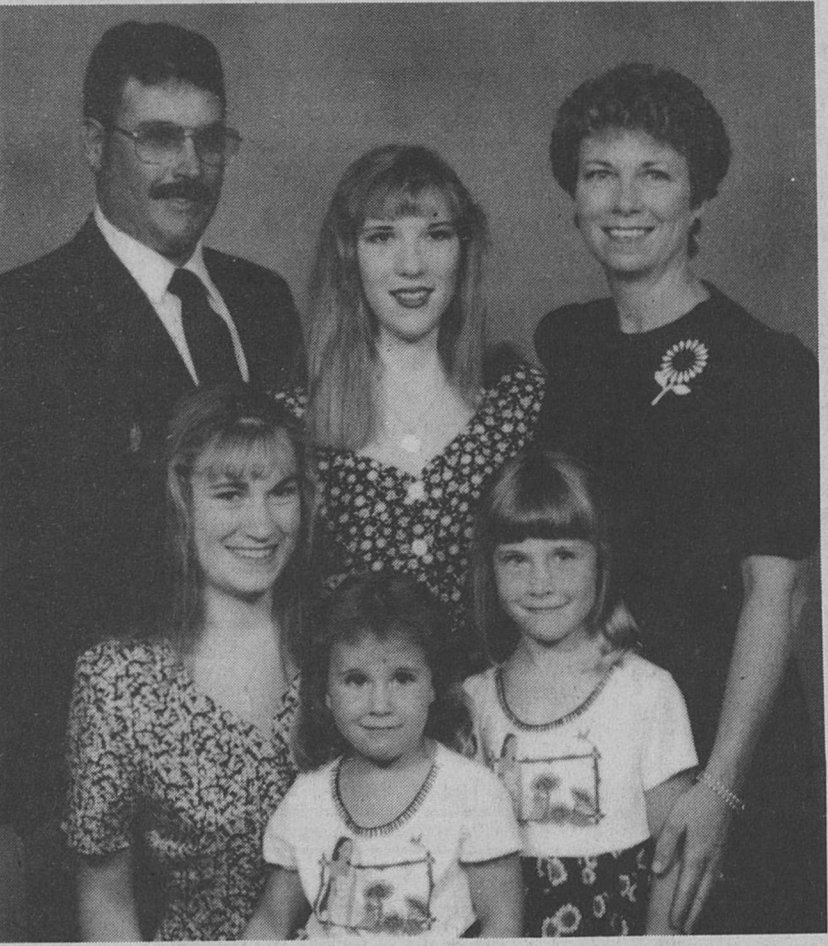
As a lifetime resident of Eagle Lake, I have family roots and community ties that are of great strength and value as we go forward and work toward a progressive county.

3. Due to a recent legislative change, residential over 65/homestead owners are now eligible for fractional over 65/homestead exemptions. If the homestead owner or their spouse turn 65 during 1997, they are entitled to additional homestead reduction for this year.

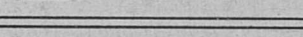
A new exemption application must be filed to receive this reduction. Please be reminded that if you are not 65 during 1997, this section does not apply to you.

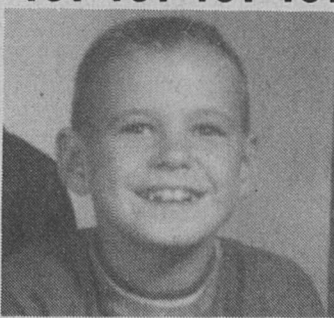
