

Hunting, fishing license cover various time spans

All hunting licenses and stamps issued by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department are valid during the license year that began Sept. 1 or the date issued through Aug. 31, 1998.

Licenses issued for a specific number of days, lifetime licenses and temporary hunting licenses have different expiration dates.

SPECIAL LICENSES

•**Resident Combination Hunting & Fishing License** (Type 100): \$32

Valid for both hunting and fishing for Texas residents only.

•**Resident "Super Combo" License Package** (Type 111): \$49 Package includes Resident Combination Hunting and Fishing license and 7 state stamp fees (5 hunting, 2 fishing) at a discount price. \$82 value if items purchased separately.

•**"The Texan" All-Purpose Resident License Package** (Type 500): \$100; package adds free park entry (Gold Texas Conservation Passport) to Super Combo above and may include preferred customer opportunities.

LIFETIME LICENSES

•**Lifetime Resident Combination Hunting & Fishing**: \$1000; **Lifetime Resident Hunting**: \$600; **Lifetime Resident Fishing**: \$600

Residents may buy hunting and fishing licenses valid for the

lifetime of the license holder. The lifetime license exempts the holder from state stamp requirements. Applications for lifetime licenses may be obtained only from Texas Parks & Wildlife offices or by calling 1-800-792-1112.

CONSERVATION PASSPORTS

•**Gold Texas Conservation Passport** (Type 292): \$50; vehicle permit provides free unlimited entry to Texas state parks for one year from month of purchase.

Includes free access to wildlife management areas during certain periods of time and designated activities, free discount tours for passport member, special quarterly newsletter and offers a discount subscription of \$10.50 for Texas Parks & Wildlife magazine. Duplicates are available for up to 2 additional vehicles (\$15 each, Type 293). Replacements if lost/stolen are available ONLY at parks (\$5, Type 294).

•**Silver Texas Conservation Passport** (Type 392): \$25; provides member with free access to wildlife management areas during certain periods of time and designated activities for one year from month of purchase.

Includes free discount tours, special quarterly newsletter and offers a discount subscription of \$10.50 for Texas Parks & Wildlife magazine.

HUNTING LICENSES

•**Special Resident Hunting*** (Type 102): \$6; valid only for residents and non-residents younger than 17, residents 65 years of age and older; and certain disabled veterans. Valid to hunt any legal bird or animal except alligators.

•**Resident Hunting** (Type 101): \$19

Required of any resident unless the resident possesses a valid: Special Resident Hunting License, Resident Combination Hunting and Fishing License, Lifetime Resident Hunting License or Lifetime Resident Combination Hunting and Fishing License. Valid to hunt any legal bird or animal (terrestrial vertebrates) except alligators.

•**Non-resident General Hunting** (Type 105): \$250; valid to hunt a legal bird or animal except alligators.

•**Non-resident Spring Turkey** (Type 118): \$100; valid to hunt turkey only during the open spring turkey season.

Holders of this license are exempt from the Turkey Stamp Fee requirements. (Unlawful to possess both this license and a valid Non-resident General Hunting License.)

•**Non-resident Special Hunting** (Type 107): \$100

Valid to hunt exotic animals, all legal game birds (except turkeys), all non-game animals (except alligators), and squirrel and

javelina (not valid for other game animals).

•**Non-resident 5-Day Special Hunting** (Type 157): \$35; legal for any period of 5 days in a row (valid hunting dates printed on the license when issued).

Valid to hunt exotic animals, all legal game birds (except turkeys), all non-game animals (except alligators) and squirrel and javelina (not valid for other game animals).

•**Non-resident Banded Bird Hunting** (Type 120): \$10

Valid to hunt banded birds on private bird hunting areas.

•**Disabled Veteran Hunting & Fishing License** (Type 502).

Qualified disabled veterans must still be licensed but there is no fee. They are still required to purchase stamps. Remember, a qualified disabled veteran is a person with a service-connected disability, as defined by the Veterans Administration, who has lost the use of a foot or leg, or has a disability rating of 60% or more, and who is receiving compensation from the U.S. for the disability. Proof of disability issued by the V.A. must be provided when applying for this license and the documentation must state the rate of disability.

•**Trapper's: Resident** (Type 106): \$15; **Non-resident of any age** (Type 115): \$250

Required for all persons to hunt, shoot, take or sell those spe-

cies classified as fur-bearing animals or their pelts.

•**Alligator Hunter's: Resident** (Type 142): \$35; **Non-resident of an age** (Type 143): \$300

Required for all persons to hunt, shoot or take alligators.

•**Hunting Lease License** (Types 132, 133 & 134): \$25 for 1 acre; \$50 for 500 through \$75 for 1,000 or more acres.

Required of anyone who leases hunting rights or charges a fee for hunting on property they own or property they control.

•**Hunting Cooperative Lease License** (Types 182 & 183).

Landowners in a county may pool their acreage licensed as a hunting lease to form a "hunting cooperative" in which the leasing profits are distributed to the landowners according to the landowners' participation.

License fee: \$60 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is less than 10,000 acres; \$120 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is between 10,000 and 50,000 acres; and \$240 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is more than 50,000 acres.

•**Wildlife Management Association Area Hunting Lease License** (Types 195, 196 & 197)

A Wildlife Management Association may obtain a special hunting lease license. **License fee:** \$30 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is less than 10,000 acres; \$60 plus \$5 per landowner if the area is more than 10,000 acres. (See Licenses, Page 9)
