- 1) Installation of carpet and floor repair in the Courthouse, and
- 2) Motorgrader, Precinct No. 3.

Bids must be received on or before Monday, December 22, 1997, at 10:00 o'clock a.m. and are irrevocable for 60 days from that time. Bids will be opened and read in Commissioners' Court of Colorado County at that time and date.

Bidder for the installation of carpet and floor repair in the Courthouse shall include in its bid proof of Workers' Compensation Insurance and General Liability Insurance Coverage in the amount of one million dollars (\$1,000,000). The successful Bidder for the installation of carpet and floor repair in the Courthouse will be required to furnish a Performance Bond if the contract is in excess of \$100,000 and a Payment Bond if the contract is in excess of \$25,000. For those contracts for the installation of carpet and floor repair in the Courthouse that are \$50,000 or less no money will be paid to the Contractor until completion and acceptance of the work.
