DISTRICT COURT DISPOSITION

On March 12, Hubert Steve Antrich was found guilty on two counts of intoxication manslaughter during a jury trial. The jury assessed four years probation plus a \$2,000 fine on each count.

April 30, Judge Dwight Peschel conducted a formal sentencing hearing and, at that time, sentenced Antrich to four year probation, a \$2,000 fine, 240 hours community service and 120 days in the county jail on one count. When that sentence is finished, the sentence on the second count will start with another four years probation, a \$2,000 fine, community service and an additional 120 days in jail.

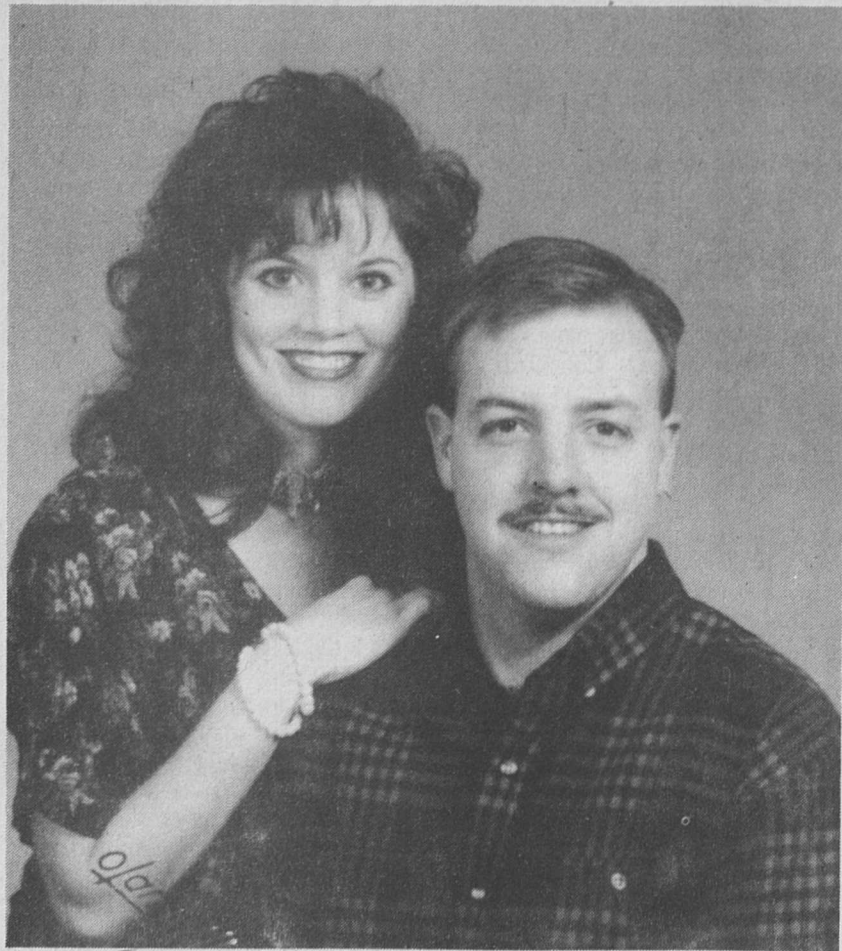
