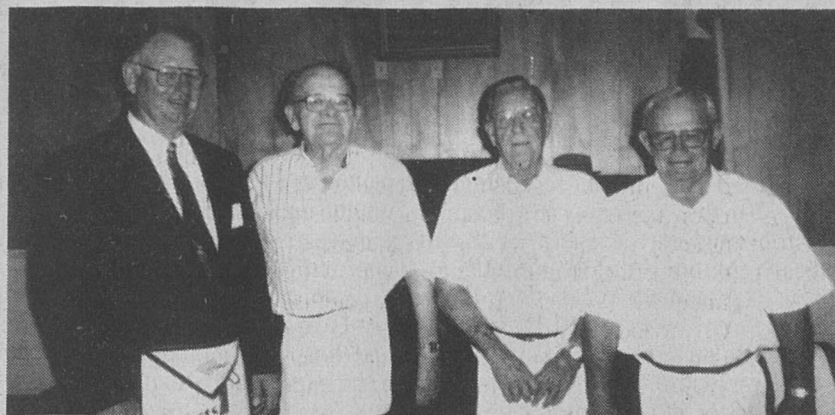

SUFFERING PAIN IN VEIN?

Our veins return blood from the extremities to the heart. Gravity would demand that the blood pool in the lowest extremity, but veins have valves to prevent back-flow. Due to the stresses of pregnancy, childbirth, or obesity, or because of hereditary factors, some leg vein valves weaken, allowing blood to pool in bulging vessels we refer to as varicose veins. When the leg veins are compromised, and the blood does pool to the foot, it may result in thickening skin in the affected foot or feet and itchy skin (due to the stretched skin the swollen area). If your feet are bothering you because of leg varicosities, your podiatrist can help you avoid foot ulcerations and infection.

Many medical conditions that affect circulation also cause damage to your feet. That's why you should see your podiatrist regularly, especially if you have any medical condition that may cause weak vein valves. 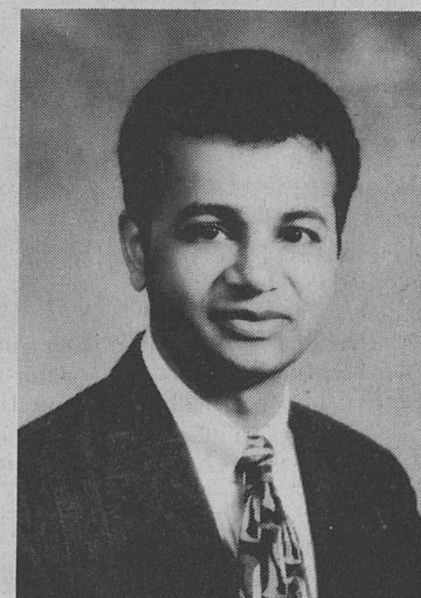
