Below are just a few of the many

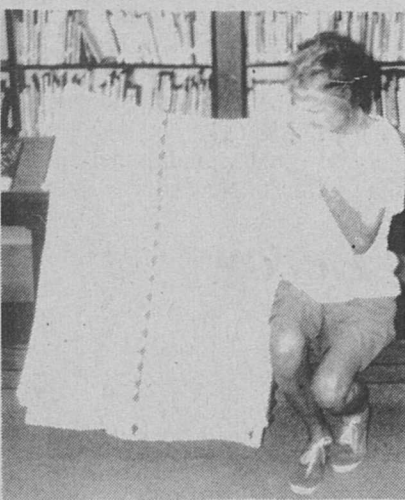
and varied items you will be able to bid on Saturday night, Oct. 24.

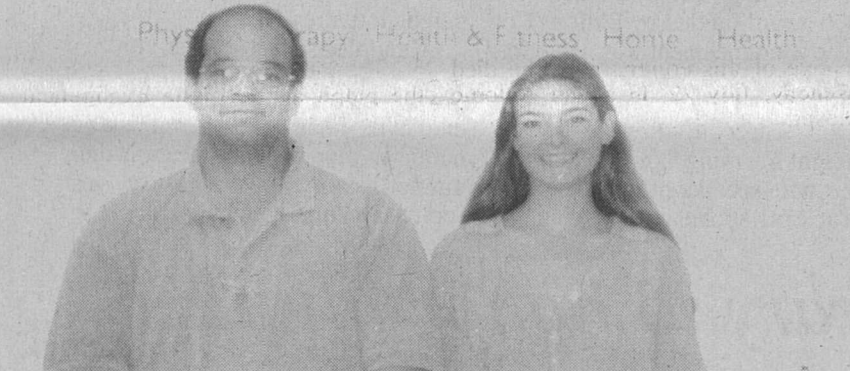
