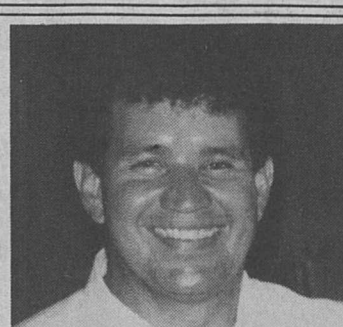

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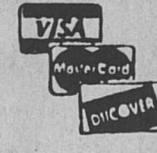
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Recently, researchers discovered a possible link between the amount of vitamin D a person consumes and progression of osteoarthritis in persons who already have the condition. Over 500 persons evaluated had been followed for more than 40 years in the famous Framingham Heart Study. A low intake of vitamin D and low blood levels of the vitamin appeared to be associated with a significant increased risk for progression of established osteoarthritis of the knee. However, researchers found no increased risk of osteoarthritis from low vitamin D in persons with previously healthy knees. Many elderly persons, especially those who stay inside away from sunlight, do not get enough vitamin D. This nutrient can be obtained from a multivitamin or single vitamin supplement. 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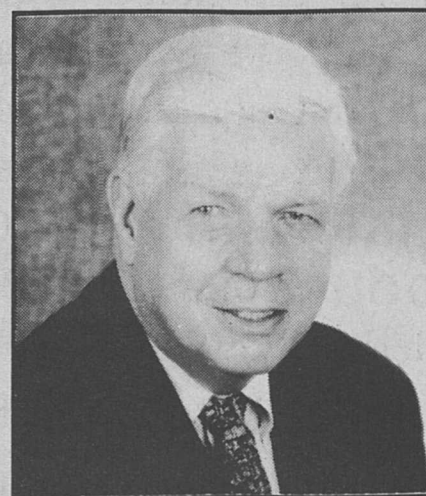
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
