Goliad County Judge Steven Paulsgrove awarded ribbons to the winners.

Colorado County 4-H members competing in the Senior Division were: Richanne Waddle, Riverside 4-

H, Main Dish; Andrew Koch, Live Oak 4-H, Nutritious Snack Category; and Hillary Thompson, Riverside 4-H, Bread and Cereal Category.

Each received a blue ribbon. Garrett Poncik, Live Oak 4-H, competed in Main Dish and Erica Trojacek, Frelsburg 4-H, competed in Bread and Cereal Category in the Junior Division.

They both received blue ribbons.

4-H members competing in the Sub-Junior Division were Kayla Pfeffer, Frelsburg 4-H, Main Dish; and Lauren Trojacek, Frelsburg 4-H, Nutritious Snack Category.

Pfeffer placed first in her category and Trojacek placed fifth in her category.

The objectives of the 4-H Food Shows are to give 4-H members the

opportunity to understand the interrelationship between food preparation, science and nutrition; understand that all individuals need the same foods, but in varying amounts, depending on age, sex, and lifestyle; develop appropriate eating habits; learn to select and purchase food in order to get the most nutrition for the money spent; develop management skills to plan, prepare,

and serve nutritious meals and snacks; understanding the social and cultural roles of food in daily living; and develop leadership and work skills to enhance personal growth and citizenship.

All contestants earned the right to

advance to the District 4-H Food Show after they won top honors at the county 4-H Food Show.

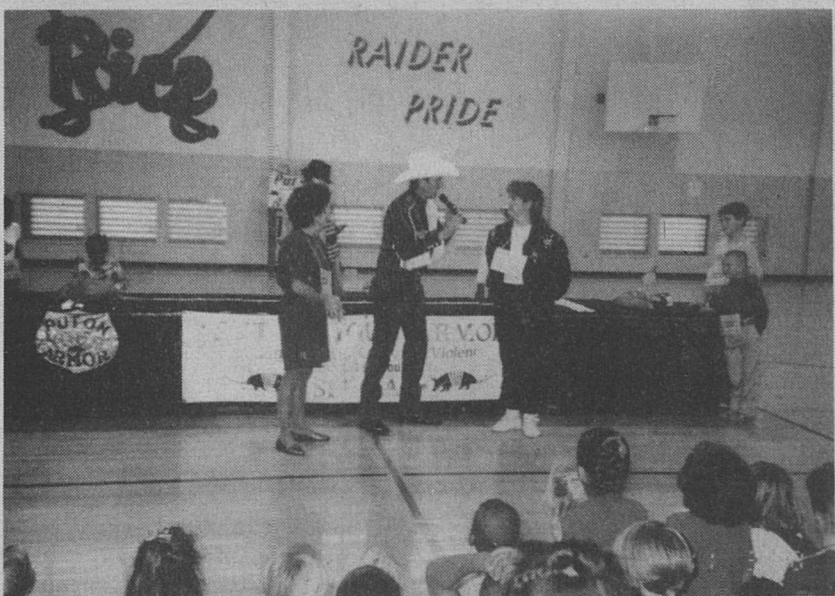
