Applicator training, testing set for April 27

There will be a Private Applicator Training and Testing held April 27 at the County Agriculture Building, 316 Spring St., Columbus. The training will be from 3 to 6:30 p.m.

The private license is required for persons who use or supervise the use of restricted-use or state-limited pesticides to produce agricultural commodities.

Agricultural commodity is defined as any plant or plant part and any animal or animal products produced for sale, feed, food or other use by humans or animals. For example: nursery stock, sod, Christmas trees, apples, cotton, corn, carrots, potatoes,

cattle, milk and eggs.

Examples of Private Applicators include farmers, ranchers, vineyardists, plant propagators, Christmas tree growers, agriculturists, floriculturists, nurserymen and growers and other similar occupations.

This training is for license and cannot be used as Continuing Education Units.

Private Applicator manuals are available at a cost of \$10.

This training is limited to 25 persons. If you plan to attend, please call the County Extension Office at 409-732-2082.
