Dress and Grooming Code (items in current Rice CISD dress code)

1. Clothing must be neat and clean in appearance and appropriate to the gender of the student; for example, boys may not wear earrings.

2. Hats, caps, head bands, bandannas, chains and hip cloths are not acceptable and are not allowed to be worn in the building at anytime. Rakes, picks and grooming combs may not be worn in hair.

3. Hair must be kept clean, neat and trimmed to a moderate length. not longer than the bottom of the earlobe. All other facial hair must be shaved. Boys' hair may not extend below a dress shirt collar or be bound in any manner.
