Breakfast and lunch prices in the Rice CISD for the 1999-2000 school term are:

Breakfast: pre-k through fifth grade, 75¢; sixth grade through 12th, \$1; adults, \$1.25; visitors, \$1.50

Lunch: pre-k through fifth, \$1.50; sixth through 12th, \$1.75; adults, \$2.25; visitors, \$2.75
