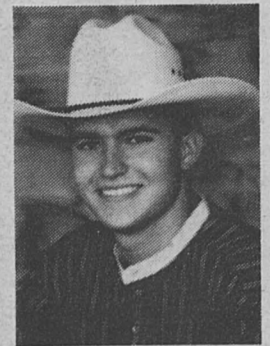
We are looking forward to the Colorado County Fair in 1999 and future endeavors of the 21st century!
