Entries are being accepted from teams who wish to compete in the Colorado County Fair Barbecue Cookoff on Saturday, September 11.

The competition, sponsored by the Colorado County Cookers Association, is open to teams cooking brisket, pork ribs, chicken and beans.

Go Texan teams may also enter the Colorado County Go Texan Cookoff at the sign in table.

The contest will be held in Columbus Community Park on Montezuma Street across from the fairgrounds.

Cooking teams will check in from 3-8 p.m. on Friday, September 10 and from 6-8:30 a.m. on Saturday. Meat will be tagged at 8:30 a.m. on Saturday.

Entry fee is \$15 per category, or \$50 for all four categories.

Judging times on Saturday will be 4 p.m. for chicken, 4:30 p.m. for beans, 5 p.m. for pork ribs and 6 p.m. for brisket.

Trophies will be awarded for first and second place winners and ribbons for third place. First and

second place trophies will also be awarded for showmanship.
