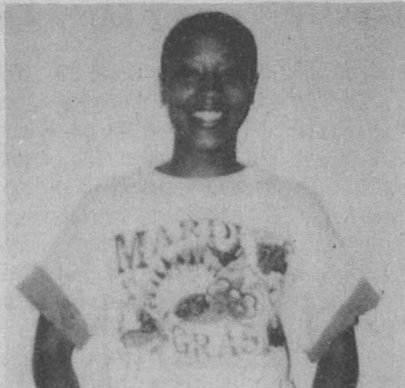

Club were also chosen. They are Frank Chavira, Felipe Rangel, Bridget Posada and Martha Reyes.

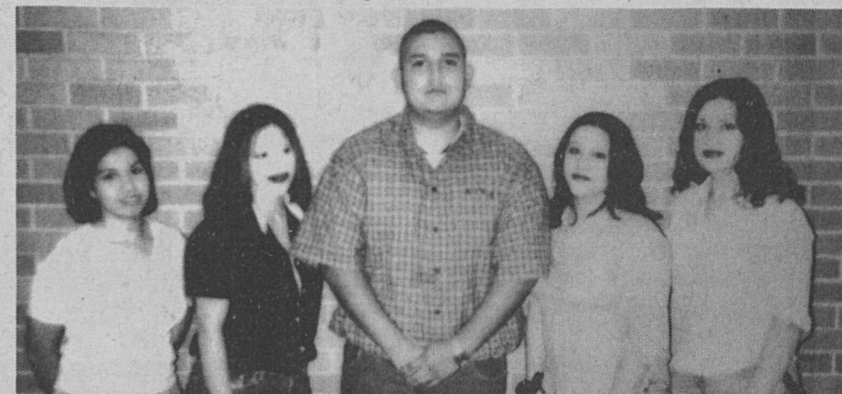

There were only two people that were stumped in guessing the picture. Kristin Thompson and Jason Barrow both said that they had no idea.

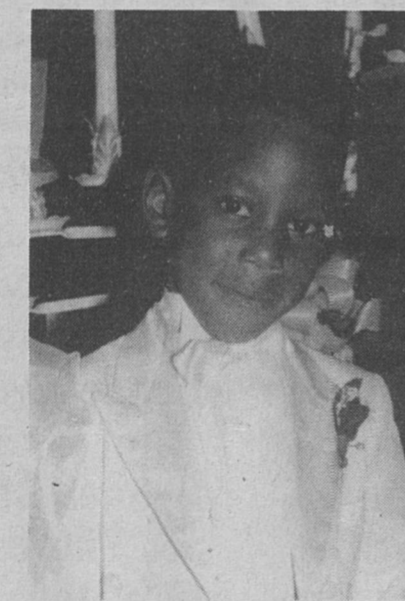
And for the many people who knew who this was, they had no problem guessing the picture.
